SALEM SCHOOLS

On Friday afternoon, the supply committee of the board of directors of the Salem Public schools, consisting of Directors Chambertin, Johnson and Condit, made a partial award of the bids for supplying the different schools with wood for the insuing year. Contracts for supplying the East, Park and Lincoln schools, aggregating 310 cords, including large and small fir and oak.

The entire contract was awarded to James Scott at an average price of \$2.3/ per cord. This is considered unneually reasonable when it is known that the award includes much oak. The amount of the contract was \$751.60. Contracts for the north and Central school supplies will be awarded in a few days, the board having a number of offers in consideration,
