FULLER TEXT OF THE OPINION

Of the United States Supreme Court On Porto Rico.

You Can Read for Yourself and Form Your Own Opinion.

Justice Brown concluded as follows: "If an act of Congress be necessary to ouvert a foreign country into domestic erritory, the question at once suggests he question, What is the character of he legislation demanded for this purpose? Will an act appropriating money for its purchase be sufficient? Apparently not, Will an act appropriating the duties collected upon imports to and from such country for the benefit of its government be sufficient? Apparently ot. Will acts making appropriations for its postal service, for the establishment of light houses, for the maintenance of quarantine stations, for erecting public buildings, have that effect? Wil an act establishing a complete local government, but with the reservation of a right to collect futies upon commerce be adequate for that purpose? None of these, nor all together will be sufficient, if the contention of the Government be sound, since acts embracing all these provisions have been passed in connection with Porto Rico, and it is insisted that it is still a foreign country within the meaning of the tariff laws. We are unable to acquiesce in this assumption that a territory may be at the same time both foreign and domestic.


