TODAY'S WORK IN CONGRESS

Isthmian Canal Bill Goes to Senate

Secretary Long's Resignation Again Rumored

Western Members Urge Columbia Improvement.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 13.—The House committee on rivers and harbors today considered the proposition to build a ship canal from Seattle to Lake Washington. Senators Turner and Foster and Congressmen Jones and Cushman, appeared before the committee and advocated in addition, canal improvements on the Columbia River at its mouth and at the Dalles at a total cost of four or five millions.

Crane May Come in.
Governor Crane of Massachusetts, had a conference with President Roosevelt this morning after which the latter saw Secretary Long in consequence of which the rumor is revived that Crane is to succeed Long in the Cabinet.

District of Columbia matters claimed the attention of the House today after the opening preliminaries were disposed of.

The Pension appropriation bill was taken up after the District bills had been reported and passed upon.

In the Senate.

In the Senate the Hepburn Isthmian Canal bill was reported from the House. Mason of Illinois then introduced a bill providing for the regulation of duties imposed on articles from Cuba imported into the United States and also a resolution providing in brief that the United States should give Cuba a board of commercial reciprocal trade, which upon his motion was laid upon the table.

Elective Senators.
Senator Dubois of Idaho, then introduced a joint resolution providing for the election of United States Senators by direct vote of the people.

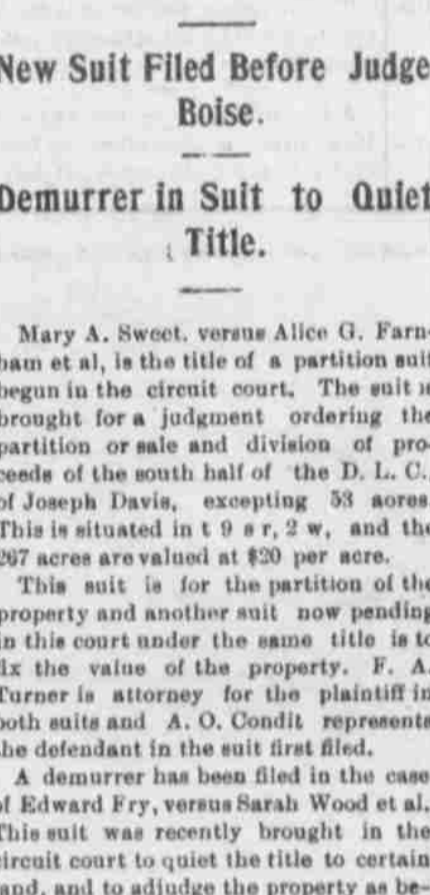

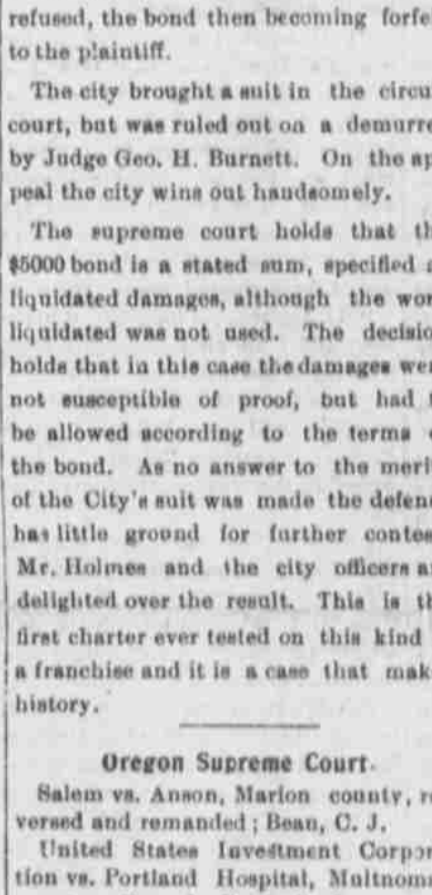

RIOTS AND WRECKS

Reported From the City of Mexico.

CITY OF MEXICO, Jan. 13.—A riot occurred yesterday at a Puebla bull fight. The bulls were bad and the populace becoming enraged drove the matadors out of the ring and burned the place to the ground.

Two serious railway wrecks occurred near here yesterday. One on the Mexican grand canal and the other on the National Ry. near Ricon, yesterday. No details are obtainable except that many were killed. The loss of life is variously estimated at from twenty to eight.

Food Receipts.
All receptacles for food should, as far as possible, be kept germ and insect free. Glass, pottery and metallic wares are therefore preferable to wood. They should have no joints or grooves, as these harbor minute particles of food. Before placing food in them they should be thoroughly washed, scalded with boiling water, wiped dry and then be allowed to cool. Placing them in the sun when practicable for a couple of hours will also add to their purity.

TO GRAB CULEBRA ISLAND

U. S. S. Leonidas Sails with Marines and Guns.

NORFOLK, Jan. 13.—The U. S. collier Leonidas sailed this morning with a heavy marine guard and field pieces presumably destined for the Island of Culebra in the West Indies which it is declared the government intends seizing.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Jan. 13.—Regardless of whether or not the United States except the Danish West Indies and thereby the harbor of St. Thomas, this country will have a coaling station strategically located in reference to the Eastern opening of the Isthmian Canal. That will be at Culebra Island just off the eastern point of Porto Rico. The North Atlantic squadron has been maneuvering off it for several weeks in anticipation of making it a thoroughly equipped and fortified naval station.
