Everything in Readiness for Celebration

Weather Permitting, Event Will Be Grand Success

The general committee held a final meeting Wednesday night, and everything is in readiness for Salem's monster Independence day celebration tomorrow. Inclement weather alone can prevent the most successful demonstration held in Oregon's capital city.

9:30—Formation of parade at city hall. Line of march will be as follows: Right of line west on Chemokeet street to Commercial street, south on Commercial street to Court street, east on Court street to High street, south on High street to State street, west on State street to Commercial street, south on Commercial street to Trade street, countermarch on Commercial street to Marion square.

It has also been arranged to have the bands, during the afternoon, stationed at the following corners: Commercial and State streets, Salem Military band; Commercial and Court streets, Indian School band; High and State streets, Monmouth band, while the remaining—the Hayseed and Reform School bands—will be held in reserve to be moved around to different places, and those stationed around on the corners will be charged around so as to give all an opportunity to hear each band.
