OREGON STATE FAIR

Interest in Exposition Over the State

What a Baker County Editor Has to Say

That the coming State Fair, to be held at the fair grounds near this city, next month, will be a greater success than any preceding exposition in this state, is a natural conclusion, when it is observed that the fair is receiving endorsement and substantial encouragement from every section of the state. The appended article on the fair is taken from the Baker City Democrat:

"While in Portland a few days ago the writer met Mr. J. W. Wisdom, publisher of the *Herald*, a widely read journal among the farmers and stockmen of the Northwest, and who is, also, secretary of the Oregon State Fair board.

"Mr. Wisdom is a brother of our prominent townsman, John W. and James T. Wisdom, and was formerly clerk of the county.

"In the conversation had with Mr. Wisdom he said the arrangements for the State Fair are progressing rapidly. The benefits that are being derived from the State Fair are becoming felt more and more by the farmers of Oregon. A number of counties are preparing a general county exhibit of the resources, which will compete for \$1000 prizes. These exhibits have attracted the attention of visitors, and will be a greater feature this year than any previous year. The fair this year will be held from September 15th to 20th, inclusive, which is about the time when the Harriman system will bring a large influx of immigrants, because of its low excursion rates. Each county in Oregon is aware of this, and is striving to put up a fine exhibit, so that when the home-seekers arrive they may see exactly what the resources of each county are.

"The fair will be something really great. All the noted herds of the Pacific Northwest will compete. This department of the fair has grown to be a show in itself, and visitors will be repaid for all the time and trouble they may devote to see the stock, as it will compare favorably with any other livestock exhibit in the United States. There are cattle, sheep, horses and swine from nearly every prominent breeder in the United States, and, in some instances, from abroad.

"The fair, as a whole, will be larger and better than ever before, and will be worth going miles to see.

"A Baker County Exhibit.

"Mr. Wisdom was very enthusiastic about Baker county being represented at the fair by an acre display and agricultural and stock exhibits. He believed a museum exhibit from Baker county would attract the attention of capitalists to our mines, and urged the importance of some one taking an interest in such an exhibit, and collecting the same.

"Mr. Wisdom, having been a resident of Baker county for many years, and still having property interests here, feels more than a passing interest in the welfare of this county. Therefore, he urges the people of Baker county to let the resources of one of the wealthiest counties in Oregon, as he expressed it, be known so that the great influx of people now pouring into this fair will have their attention called to the advantages offered here for the investment of their money, in farming, stockraising, mining and a thousand other things."

Big Missionary Meeting.

Atlanta, Ga., Aug. 20.—The fourth annual camp meeting and convention of the Christian Missionary Alliance began today at Exposition Park, and will continue until the end of the month. There will be many sessions each day, from early morning until late at night. Many well-known preachers and workers are present, including Rev. A. B. Simpson, of New York, president of the Christian and Missionary Alliance; Rev. Henry Wilson, of New York, field superintendent; Rev. W. F. Meninger, of Chicago, also field superintendent, and other distinguished workers and preachers. A number of missionaries, who have returned from China, the Congo and other foreign fields, are also present and will be heard during the meeting.

This reporter interviewed me, and stated it was rather suspicious to him the way Tongue ran ahead of me and threw me in the dark while he was so interested in the frauds, and the reporter knowing the relations of Tongue with the timber frauds, began a hearty laugh, saying: "I know some delicate paths for Tongue, who knows more than he cares to know, and does not want to commit himself."
