MORE AND MORE.

The aggressions of the trusts are driving labor to demand a larger share of the products of industry. In pursuing its campaign to secure its large or share of the productive wealth of a country organized labor is only following a logical course.

The South Chicago railway employees have recently secured an advance of wages on this basis, and while railroad managers water their stock to absorb earnings, laborers are striving forward also.

The street railway had an agreement under which it paid monthly and at the rate of 17 1/2 cents an hour the first year, 18 cents the second, 18 1/2 the third, and 19 cents thereafter.

Under the new schedule they will pay semi-monthly at the rate of 15 cents an hour the first six months and 20 cents an hour after the first six months. These are great gains to be made at one bound, but are not unreasonable.

The only danger is that wages will be advanced, and the prices of all articles will be advanced to the consumer, so that it will stimulate both over-production and under-consumption.

Then will come the tug of war for industrial existence. The period of depression has terrors for both capital and labor—but more for the latter than for the former, because the capitalist can live on his capital.

It must be admitted that state socialism presents the only final solution to the struggle, unless laborers are the greatest consumers.

HOOKS BAITED WITH REFORM.

It must be a great source of satisfaction for advocates of reform, and those who are opposed to trusts and stock watering to find a great Oregon newspaper that has always had the confidence of the corporations shouting on their side.

It must be a hopeful indication that public sentiment is not dead when an editor who has always ridiculed those who have demanded these reforms turns about and vehemently demands them himself.

But instead of electing him to a high office as a reward for his change of heart they should elect one of the pioneers of these reforms, and ask the newer and zealous convert to work at the plowshare for awhile.

Hooks baited with reform are suspicious, and may only be to land a wily politician in the Senate, where he would be a far different kind of fisherman from what he is when standing on the banks of the national stream angling for votes.

It will be remembered that Grover Cleveland could make grand speeches, full of octo-syllabic thunder against the trusts, but when he went into office on the reform wave he was one of their dumb and driven cattle.

Flattery of organized labor, howling for socialistic remedies and writing editorials sprawling all over with populism may land an editor in the United States Senate, but the leopard's spots will remain unchanged.

A GREAT WHITE STONE.

A great white milestone in history has been set in honor of King Edward by the visit of the Boer generals from South Africa to England, and the almost royal reception given them by the people of all classes.

Greater than all the honors of the coronation is the honor King Edward has conferred on the nation and on himself and all humanity by the peace brought about with those unfortunate people so long under arms.

Generals Botha, Dewet and Delarey were greeted by the greatest men and women of England, and by the great-hearted common people. The feeling in England is but typical of the sympathy of the world.

The Boer leaders, who with little handfuls of men hold the greatest armies of Europe at bay, are raising funds for the widows and orphans of their country, and will come to the United States on a similar mission.
