PLEASED WITH THE VALLEY

Kansas Officials Visit Oregon's Capital Building

Praise Oregon's Management of State Institutions

A. A. Colvard, attorney-general, and A. D. Drake, chairman of the railroad commissioners of the state of Kansas, were Salem visitors Thursday, going to Portland last evening, on their way to the coast.

The gentlemen were accompanied by their families, and their visit to Salem was the termination of a pleasure trip to the Pacific coast, which was also their initial visit to this section of the country.

The Kansas officials were favorably impressed with the Willamette valley, but expressed surprise that it was not more thickly settled. In this relation, they commented on the remarkable opportunities for settlement that are offered here, and predicted for Western Oregon an extensive development, in view of the large influx of immigration to these parts.

Attorney-General Colvard is of the opinion that the manner of the administration of Oregon's state institutions is an improvement over that followed in the "Sunflower" state. In Kansas the management and control of state institutions are vested in a board of managers that is appointed by the governor, which, he says, practically places the administration of the same within the control of the governor himself. To have different institutions controlled by a board of the state officers instead, he thinks, removes largely the liability of the public service being sacrificed for the advancement of political interests. Another respect in which Mr. Colvard thinks the management of the Oregon state institutions is superior to that of the state he represents, is the fact that here all of the state buildings are located at one point, which simplifies their administration, and facilitates the purchase of supplies, which can be obtained more reasonable than otherwise, and the result is a more economical conduct of each and all of the institutions. There are at the present time, there are three insane asylums, one of which was established about four years ago, and is close proximity to one of the asylums that was already established in one of the remote corners of the state. The consequence is an increased item of expense in the transportation of the state's charges, that could be readily avoided were the institutions centrally located.

While in the city the gentlemen and their families visited the state house, and called upon such of the state officers as were in their offices. The gentlemen had a pleasant visit with Governor Geer, Secretary of State Dunbar and State Treasurer Moore, and they called upon having such a splendid group of officers, whom they found most courteous and obliging in their attention and treatment of callers.
