STATE LAND BOARD

Disposed of Considerable Routine Work Tuesday

Ordered all Holders of Certificates of Sale of Less Than \$50 to Pay up at Once

The state land board was in session at the state house yesterday afternoon for the purpose of disposing of a quantity of routine business. Among the matters coming up for consideration was the application of John Adair, Jr., of Clatsop county, for the refunding of the sum of \$800 paid for swamp land in 1872, and for interest at the rate of 5 per cent on the sum paid, the total claim aggregating about \$2000. The board is opposed to paying the interest charge, unless the attorney-general, to whom the matter has been referred for an opinion, should decide that the sum is due. The claim grows out of the sale of swamp land under the act of 1870, and Adair's certificate was issued in 1872. In 1887 the legislature called in all swamp land certificates on which less than 25 per cent had been paid, and the holders were reimbursed for their payments. This is one of the certificates called in, but was not presented until a few days ago, and the question is on the payment of the interest.

The board yesterday ordered that the clerk notify all holders of certificates of sale for school lands, owing less than \$50, to pay up at once, or their certificates would be cancelled. There are over 400 of these certificates outstanding, and the holders of the lands have escaped taxation by reason of the lands standing in the name of the state. In order to have the lands properly recorded and taxed, and to dispose of all the small balances carried on the books of the state land office, this order was made, and the holders of these certificates, many of whom are on the lands, which are valuable, will either have to pay and have the titles in their own names and pay taxes on the property, or the certificate will be cancelled, and the lands will be resold.
