Mr. John Brooks, of Silverton, went to Portland this morning, after a short visit in Salem, and he will spend a few days with his daughter, Mrs. R. H. Leabo, of Portland, before returning to his home.

Mayor C. P. Bishop this morning signed the new bicycle ordinance passed by the city council at last Tuesday's meeting, and the new law will go into effect on August 25th, 30 days after the signature of the mayor was affixed.

Raymond Stevens, a son of G. S. Stevens, of Yew Park, met with a serious accident yesterday while riding on a load of hay. While the driver was on the ground the horses took fright and ran away, and the lad falling off the load, broke both bones of the left leg above the ankle. He was at once taken to the Salem Hospital, where the fracture was reduced.

Not a Case Of Just the Cheese

Albert Wilkes, while driving his four-horse wagon to this city on Saturday, with 50 boxes of cheese, belonging to Miller & Gangloff, met with a bad smashup, which gave him a close call. He was on the grade, two miles the other side of Beaver, on the Big Nestucca, when the wagon toppled over the grade, and went down 80 feet before it stopped. Wilkes and the horses were carried with the wagon, making a general mix-up, and the boxes of cheese landing in the river. Fortunately Wilkes was not badly injured, although he was shook up and bruised some and the only injury to the horses was in being scratched. Dan Miller, on hearing of the accident, went out and fished out the boxes of cheese, although he had to take a cold bath in doing so.—Tillamook Headlight.
