WANTS COIN BACK

The Baroness Halkett to Recover the Price of Herself

Has Secured a Divorce but now Sues for the Boot She Gave to get a Baron

London, Aug. 10.—Society, especially that element in it which has married in America, is profoundly stirred by the announcement that Baroness Halkett, who was Miss Sarah Phelps Stokes, the daughter of Anson Phelps Stokes, the New York multimillionaire, who recently secured a divorce from her husband on the ground of extreme cruelty, intends to sue for the setting aside of the millions settled upon Baron Halkett at the time of the marriage.

Behind this announcement is a story that Baroness Halkett's suit will simply be the first of a series which will, in the end, include members of the nobility in nearly every country in Europe, who have married rich American girls, secured enormous dowries, and then, by systematic abuse, amounting in many instances to brutality, have compelled them to seek relief in the divorce courts, while they hold on to the American dollars without the incumbrance of an American wife. Usually they accomplish the result within a couple of years of marriage.

If Baroness Halkett is successful in her suit, and some of the best lawyers in the kingdom are sure she will be, hereafter the European nobleman who goes seeking for an allowance with an American wife must make up his mind to keep the wife or give up the cash.

Inasmuch as Baroness Halkett is enormously rich in her own right, and besides in this matter has the active sympathy and support of her multi-millionaire brothers in New York, and of other American noblewomen, who are in the same position she is, there will be no difficulty so far as money is concerned in fighting the case through the highest court, and with the best legal talent at the British bar.

The success of Baroness Halkett would mean the beginning of similar suits, not only in England, but in France, Germany, Italy, Austria and Russia.
