## THROWING MUD AT HOFER

### All Right to Skin Citizens Who Are Not Candidates

### But it Is Personal Abuse to Tread on the Toes of Political Managers.

Editor Journal: Of course it is all right to sail in and plug it to Colonel E. Hofer, which isn't personality when it comes from certain sources, but if the Colonel dares to defend his own good name, then the cry is raised that personality is the issue, and that everybody who thinks as the Colonel does is wrong. The facts of the business are that the Hon. E. Hofer is just a little bit the best man with the pen when it comes to all-round campaigning, and forgetting this fact, the Citizens' press committee laid themselves open by an opening gun of nothing else but ridicule and abuse, to their loud and public sorrow. They are now demanding a cessation of personality. They got only what was deserved. No personality was indulged from Republican headquarters until the fire was drawn by ungentlemanly criticism from the opening columns of the Citizens' press committee, through columns hired for that purpose. What else did they expect? People living in glass houses are liable to get a window light broken out when they attack a neighbor passing by the house peacefully. This lesson was probably needed and therefore was well given.
