Concerning the Initiative. In response to an inquiry from the Secretary of State as to the last date upon which initiative petitions can be filed so as to entitle them to be placed on the official ballot, General

Crawford last evening handed down an opinion, naming the fifth day of February as the date, as the election this year falls on June 6th, and the law requires four months time to elapse between the filing of initiative petitions and the election at which they are to be voted upon. The Attorney General holds that the time for filing these petitions changes from year to year as the day of elec-

tion changes—the first Monday in June does not always fall on the same date—and he therefore names February 5th as the date on which petition can be received by the state department.
