**VIEWS OF THE PROHIBITION**

Thinks Those Who Vote for License Lawmakers as Bad as the Saloon Keepers

Salem, Feb. 4, 1904.

Ed. Journal: I see by reading account of council proceedings in The Journal that one man was granted two liquor licenses and had applied for a third, which was referred to the license committee. It does not appear that there was any objection or even that the matter was at all discussed. Some of the members did not think that they had any right to refuse to grant it under the law it will be remembered that the law requires that the applicant should be of good moral character to entitle him to a license. And just here I would remark that a person could not possibly have a good moral character and be engaged in the saloon business for the reason that the business in itself is not moral. A business that produces so much crime and wickedness cannot be moral. But, someone will say that it's the law, and that we need and must have the revenue. The saloon keepers will point to his license on the wall and say, "there, that is my authority; if that is wrong, then you are wrong, for you voted for the law which gives me my authority to sell, and you have taken my money for the license and have no right to complain of the consequences. I am as good as you are." And he is, if you knowingly voted for it, or for the party that stands for a license law to legalize and make respectable the most blighting curse that afflicts humanity. 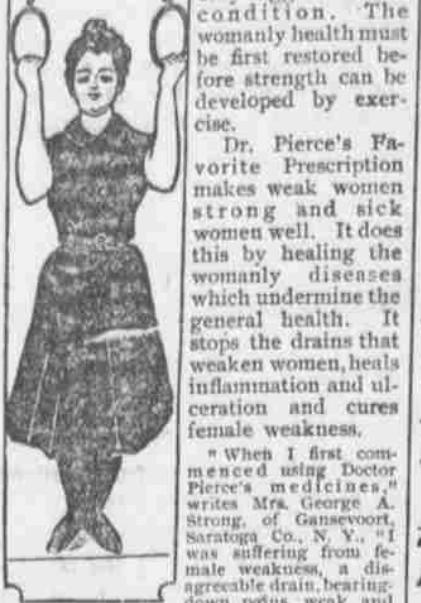
