LUCKY BOY IS READY

Has Installed Lots of New and First Class Machinery

Mr. Zimmerman, One of the Owners Says Company Will Build Hotel at Mill

Louis Zimmerman has just returned from a visit to the Lucky Boy mine. He says the machinery is all in the new mill ready to start. The electric power plant on the McKenzie river is almost finished and a transmission line is ready for the current to be turned on. All there is to do is the installing of the transformer at the mill. Mr. Zimmerman expects the mill to be running in less than a month. The transmission line has come through the late storm without any damage whatever. This has been a very severe test and they now feel assured that the line will give them no trouble when the "juice" is turned on.

Mr. Zimmerman informs us that his company intends at once to commence the erection of a hotel on their property. The plans for the building are already prepared and at the time. The foundation will be of stone up to the first story. The building will be 40x60 feet and three stories high, and will have a veranda twelve feet wide running completely around it. The hotel will be first-class in every respect and is intended for a summer resort. Mr. Zimmerman, expects to have the house opened for guests on the 1st of July. In addition to the hotel the company are to put up a building for a general store. This will be 40x80 feet, two stories high and will be furnished with an ice plant and cold storage room, where meat, butter, eggs and other perishable merchandise can be kept throughout the summer. A complete cyanide plant will also be added to their new stamp mill by means of which they will be able to save almost 100 per cent of their values.

Arrangements have been made with Mr. Bangs to run his stage on to Lucky Boy after June 1, instead of stopping at Blue River as heretofore.

Investigation showed where the fire had originated and that preparations for it had not been accidental. A rear porch is practically inclosed by lattice work, and inside this and against the siding of the house were found three charred sticks of stove wood carefully crossed over a black piece of rough cloth which smelled strongly of coal oil. The flames had mounted to the top of the ceiling on the inside of the house and had burned a good size hole through the siding. The escape from a disastrous conflagration was narrow.

The dastardly act cannot be explained in any other way than that it was the work of an irresponsible or insane person and the officials investigating it have been working on the theory. It is reported that a certain party is under surveillance who has exhibited on several occasions recently an incendiary mania, sufficiently dangerous to call for his commitment to the care of the authorities.

New Irrigation System.

The bonus has been assured and ample capital enlisted for the construction of the new irrigation canal to lead from upper Klamath lake near the Falls, it is reliably reported, and the final steps will be taken, today, it is expected, to assure the early commencement of the enterprise which will bring 24,000 acres of land under water and add untold wealth and productiveness to the Klamath country.
