## NO HARD LABOR IN JAIL

Sentence Providing for This Must Be Changed by the Trial Court

In the supreme court this afternoon the appeal case of Chas. Houghton, who was convicted in the justice court in Multnomah county, and sentenced to serve six months in the county jail "at hard labor," was decided, the court reversing the decision of the trial court, on the ground that a jail sentence did not carry with it hard labor, and the case was sent back, the defendant to be resentenced, in accordance with the statutes, which do not provide for hard labor in the county jail.

The case of Maud Marie Stringham against the Mutual Life Insurance Company, of New York, was also reversed. The plaintiff in this case secured a judgment in the trial court for \$1000, the amount of a life insurance policy applied for by her husband, but which was not ready for delivery until after he had died, as the result of pneumonia. It was also shown that he had given his note for the premium, and that the premium itself was not paid until after he became ill. The company moved the trial court to dismiss the case, and the motion being overruled, a trial was had, and an appeal was the result. The supreme court holds that the case should have been properly dismissed, as the premium was paid after the applicant for insurance was ill, and that this was unknown to the company or its agents.

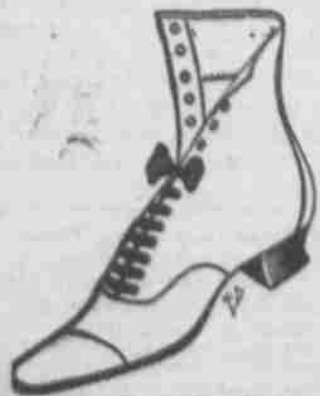
