Hood River, Or., April 6.—Mrs. Leonard Day, wife of an employe at the Menominee sawmill, four miles below town, while attempting to extinguish the flames from an exploding kerosene lamp in her house yesterday afternoon, met death by cremation.

While the accident happened at 3 o'clock the woman lingered in agony three hours, and was conscious to the very last.

Every stitch of clothing was burned from her body. Not a particle of skin remained untouched, while some of it was charred black. Mrs. Day was 27 years old. She leaves, besides her parents, a husband and a 5-year-old boy.

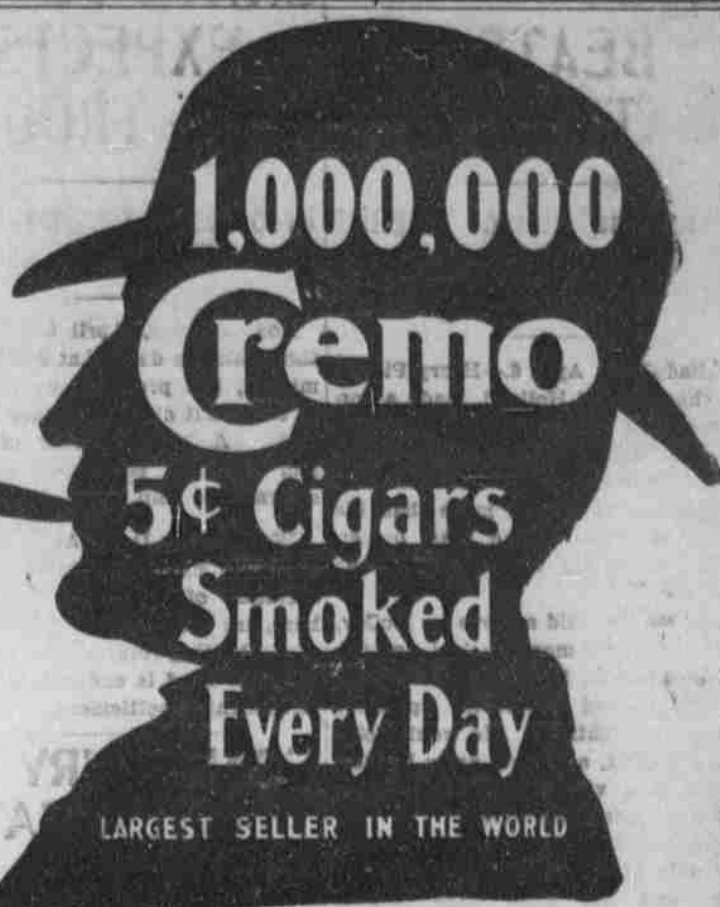

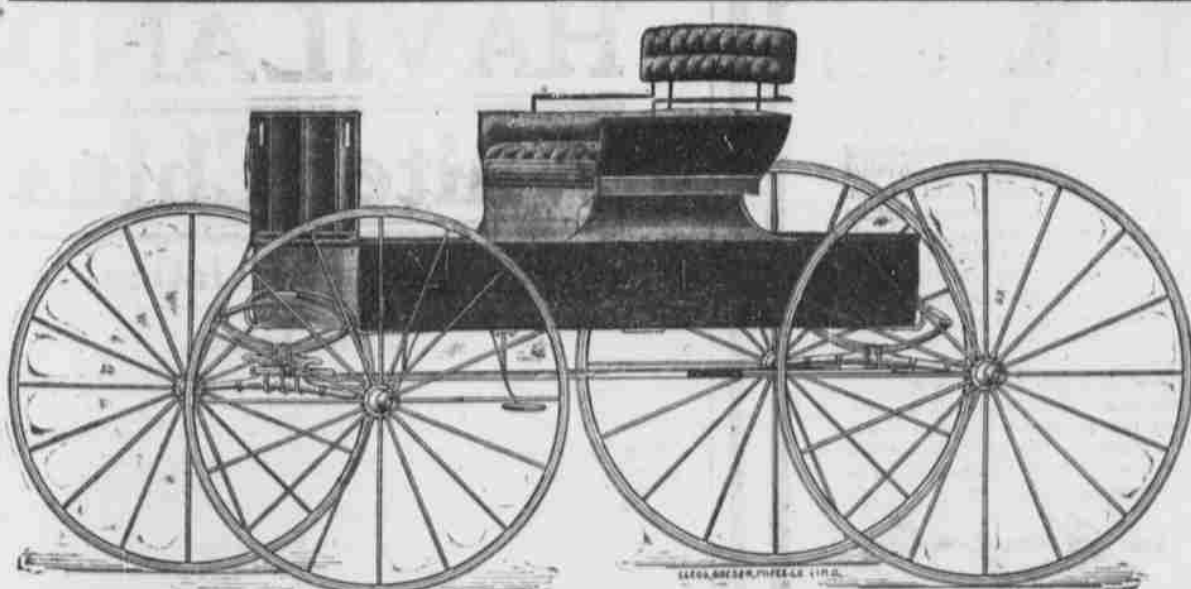

Were your legs ever cramped in a long ride? Our buggy has plenty of leg room.

Can you sit comfortably two in a seat and find room for a lap robe without getting a great big heavy buggy? We flare the sides of our seats so as to give you plenty of room and yet retain a light, attractive appearance.

How much good is the spring back of your buggy? Does it touch you only at the shoulders, or at the small of the back where you want it? Look at the cut of our Bee Line buggy and see the shape of the back.

Is the back of your buggy high enough? Ours is very high.

Did you ever have a corner open? Ours are secure. See our corner iron.

Did you ever have a seat riser break loose? Ours are screwed to heavy oak strips 5 inches wide and 12 inches long.

Did you look at the lid of your curtain box? Query: Is the rest of your buggy built as carelessly as the curtain box and lid? We are careful of every part.

Is the brace on the inside of your seat rest over 1 1/2 inches wide? Ours is 5 inches.

Is your curtain box lid a make-believe, or is it deep enough so you can put your apron and curtains away safely? Our box is four inches deep in the clear and your curtains and aprons will not mould.

Did you ever have a seat pull apart? Ours will not.

How do you think the panel back is put on your buggy? Look at it from behind and you may see (that it is not braced at all). Our backs are finished the same as phaeton backs. Look at the Bee Line buggy and see the bracing.

Do you sometimes put your foot on the panel of your bug-

gy? Of course, you should not! Well, if you do, the solid edge iron that we use will protect the panel from wearing away or splitting off.

Does the toe rail on your buggy support your foot just where you want it, or does your foot rest on the front panel of your buggy? Look and see. In our buggy, if anyone touches their feet to the front panel they want to be "onry." There is no need of it.

Do you find the bottom of your buggy gives way? Ours is oak.

Look on the inside of your buggy—that is, in the cushion box. Is it painted? Why not? Won't the wet harm this wood the same as any other? Ours is painted.

Do you ever have plugs show on the panel and seat risers of your buggy? Our seat risers are screwed on from the inside, no plugs to show. We dare anyone to show with us on bodies.
