RODENTS RAISE RUCTION

Rats Devour a Section of Copper Wire and Put Out Electric Lights

Salem rats must be very hungry, or else have a grudge against the electric light people, for they devoured a small section of wire the other evening, and caused an endless amount of trouble. A well-known restaurant in this city had a rush during the early part of the night, and the cook was right in the middle of compounding several French dishes, although he has an Asiatic pedigree, when the juice suddenly went a glimmering, and cooks, cashiers, deckhands and roustabouts were left in utter darkness. The expert electricians were soon on the ground, and later on the roof, but for a long time they were puzzled to know the cause of the sudden stoppage. After prospecting around the premises to their hearts' content one of the "fixers" discovered a severed wire, where connections were made over an annex, and it was at first thought that some mischievous person had planned a joke, but on a closer investigation the work of rodents was very plain. The insulation had been nibbled away, and, to make the job complete, they had gnawed through the copper wire, disconnecting the circuit. The rats may have been taking the electrical treatment for rheumatism or that tired feeling, but the shock received in the restaurant when the glim went out was equal to anything experienced by them.

CORSETS MAY CAUSE CANCERS.

English Physician Puts Ban on Female Waist Baskets.

London, April 21.—Writing to the Lancet, Dr. R. C. Lucas adds a new count to the indictment against the corset—namely, that under certain circumstances it may be responsible for cancer.
Three cases have come under the doctor's notice in which cancer in women started at a point where the edge of the corset crossed the edge of the big muscles of the chest. In describing two of them, he says:
"It occurred on the right side in each case and in women whose occupation led them to undue use of the right arm, and in consequence, to excessive friction of the upper edges of the corset. Friction of the corset at this spot is, therefore, the cause of the cancerous process developing in this situation, and, to express the fact, I have given it the name of corset cancer."

Seattle Man Has Confidence in the Future of the Great North West

Edwin Wallace, of Seattle, was at the Willamette yesterday on his return from a trip into California. In speaking about the weather, Mr. Wallace said: "The North Coast has rain, but California has not been far behind this winter. At Redding it has rained 52 days in succession, and was raining when I left the town. There is not a crosswalk in the town, except one or two in the business district, and you can imagine how people waded through mud. Usually the winters are so dry that walks of any kind are unnecessary, but this season everything was different. It was a steady downpour, and the country was flooded."

Mr. Wallace has great faith in the states of Oregon and Washington, and believes a splendid future awaits the entire coast.

Hemp Neckties Ready.

Chicago, Ill., April 21.—The sheriff of Cook county has completed all arrangements for the triple execution tomorrow, where the car barn bandits, Marx, Neidermeier and Van Dine will pay the penalty of their crimes. It will be the first time that more than two men have been hanged at once in Chicago since the execution of the Haymarket anarchists.

The sheriff's office has been flooded with requests for tickets to witness the execution, but all of these have been refused. The only witnesses to the triple hanging will be those who attend in official capacity. All of the condemned youths appear to be bearing up well, but some fear is expressed that Marx may break down at the critical moment.
