STATE REPUBLICANS READY FOR BATTLE

Oregon Stalwarts Prepared to Fire Shot That Will Reverberate Over Entire Country

Portland, Or., April 29.—"Republican state committee, walk in," reads the new sign on the door of Frank C. Baker, chairman. "And don't forget the 'walk in,'" says Mr. Baker, "nor the chairs inside."

Mr. Baker is getting ready to smite the Democratic foe. On his table are a new bottle of ink and countless letters. From the ink he draws the orders which he sends forth to the captains in all the counties. Never is the arsenal so remote that it is beyond the word of Frank C. Baker, Commander-in-Chief. And like Caesar, Mr. Baker knows each of his captains by name.

"Oregon will fire the shot that will be heard all over the United States," declared Mr. Baker in the midst of writing a letter.

"It will be the first gun of the national campaign. It will electrify the whole country. Don't you remember before the last Presidential election? Won't it thrill that convention when somebody strides to the front like a plumed knight, bearing aloft the tidings from Oregon?"

When Mr. Baker needs an ejaculation he makes use of "Holy crow." That's what he exclaimed at this juncture of his remarks, for he was thrilled with the scene all the way down his spinal marrow into his toes. "Holy crow," he declared, "that convention will go wild, think of it! Don't you remember how the national convention of 1888 let loose its enthusiasm over the Republican victory in Oregon? How the convention was held right after the election in this state? How Hermann beat Gearin for Representative in congress by 7000 votes. How that was the greatest Republican victory ever achieved in Oregon up to that time?"

"Let's see," went on Mr. Baker, clearing his throat and straddling his nose with his spectacles. Whereupon he dived into his archives and learned

that in 1888 about 60,000 votes had been cast, and that in 1902 the number was about 88,000. "Out of 60,000 votes in 1888, the Republican plurality was 7000. Out of 88,000 votes in 1902, the Republican plurality was 17,000. "This year there should be 100,000 votes and the Republican plurality should be 20,000," said he.

"It's all a question of getting voters to the polls, for if they go, they'll vote Republican. Many electors, certain that Oregon is overwhelmingly Republican, won't feel like hitching up Jenny and driving to the polls. But all should turn out and give Roosevelt a big majority. We need to increase the Republican lead of two years ago. If we don't we're just as well off not to hold an election this year. The bigger Oregon's vote for Roosevelt, the louder will be Oregon's voice of confidence in his administration."
