## SAY HE TOOK MONUMENT

### George H. Himes Accused of Removing Historical Astoria Relle

Astoria, Or., Ma 4.-George H. Himes, secretary of the Oregon His torical society, is accused of taking from Astoria the monument which marked the resting place of McTavish English representative, who was drowned off Fort Astoria in 1818, At the last meeting of the Chamber of Commerce it was decided to mark all historic spots in this vicinity apropos of the Lewis and Clark fair, and also to collect relies of early days. Discuscussion brought out the charge that Mr. Himes had carried off the monument of McTavish, who was here when Fort Astoria was taken over by English and renamed Fort George. At last night's meeting of the Council a letter was read from President Welch of the Chamber of Commerce who requested the council to take such action as would insure the return of monument and cause the punishment of the person who carried it the largest bamboo pole ever seen off.
