

INTERESTS COMMON PEOPLE

Direct Primary Bill to Come Before Voters in June

Republicans Enact Laws for the Benefit of the Masses, as Shown by Action in Past Campaign

Many reform measures in the interest of the people, measures similar to the one now before the voters for action, known as the direct primary bill, have been enacted through the efforts and support of the Republican party. Some years ago the People's party was born and many measures were advocated by that organization that have since been enacted into law by the Republican party, and are now in the statute books. Chief of these is the initiative and referendum amendment to the constitution. For years the People's party advocated the adoption of this measure in vain, but when the Republican party had made a thorough study of the proposed amendment, and had ascertained that it was a safeguard for the people, it was speedily passed and became the law of the state—a part of the organic law. Other similar measures might be named that, first advocated for the benefit of the masses, were enacted into law by the Republican party, the party that has always stood for the best interests of the common people, from its birth to the present day.

This is the party that has, in a measure, set the stamp of its approval on the direct primary bill now before the voters for their action, and the fate of the measure can be safely entrusted to the party of Lincoln, Grant, McKinley and Roosevelt, the party that does things for the people and their best welfare. The indications are that at the coming election, the 6th day of June, next, the bill will pass by a large majority, and will be placed before the next legislature for enactment into law as the will of the people of Oregon, and it is useless to think that the assembly will ignore the measure.

Only by the united support of the Republican party can this measure be enacted into law, and this support is certain. In view of this fact, it seems that the Populist party, an organization that has for some time advocated measures of this character in the interest of the common people would be where its friends are to be found, and would give the Republican party the assistance required to properly and thoroughly put into effect the reform measures, such as the direct primary, under consideration. The leaders of the Republican party, to a man, are pledged to this and similar laws, the enactment of which will for all time do away with the pernicious system of bossism that has in the past characterized political methods; and the view of this the members of the People's party can do no better than give the Republicans the necessary assistance to assure the enactment of the very much desired law.

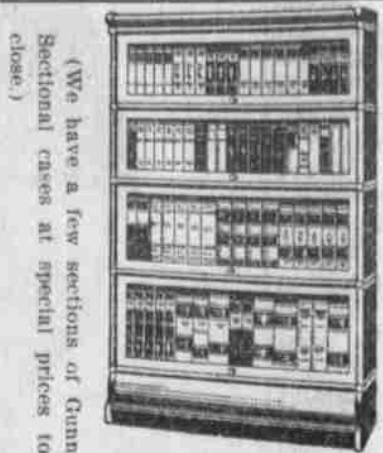
