ROWE'S AMUSING EXPERIENCE

How Wild Animals Were Put Ashore

Drivers and Truckmen Afraid to Handle the Royal Menagerie

Manager Rowe of the Norris & Rowe circus relates an amusing experience that happened him recently. Charlie Jordan of the "Five Flying Jordans," who went to India recently, cabled Manager Rowe from Bombay that an English circus which had been touring the Indian provinces were about to disband and asking permission to purchase the best of the collection of wild beasts. Mr. Rowe promptly cabled instructions to buy and ship immediately. The collection included a big lion and lioness, a fine tiger, a performing cub bear, some large eagles, a group of monkeys, a tapir and a llama.

Upon being notified of the steamers arrival from Calcutta, Mr. Rowe hurried to San Francisco to secure his prizes and transfer them to the winter quarters at San Jose. With him went Geo. Belford and Harry LaVan, acrobats connected with the Norris & Rowe shows, who were anxious to see the collection and assist in having them conveyed to the winter quarters.

Upon their arrival at San Francisco, Mr. Rowe contracted with one of the great draying concerns to haul the lot from the wharf to the railroad depot for re-shipment, but here is where Mr. Rowe's troubles began. He had neglected to state to the transfer people just what the freight consisted of. Mr. Rowe gave the steamship people the word that everything was in readiness to unload and they were glad enough to get rid of their unwelcome freight. As cages of lions, tigers, etc., began pouring out of the hold and were gracefully dumped on the wharf by the giant cranes, the trouble began. Horses are notoriously afraid of wild beasts and the transfer company were no exception so they did not wait on ceremony but made frantic efforts to escape. The teamsters looked blankly at one another and began murmuring. They hauled about everything in the freight line but this was a new one on them, their animals could not be induced to back upon the wharf and it seemed impossible to load the wild beasts. They held a hasty consultation among themselves and decided to refuse the job and refuse quick, the angry snarls, growls and roars of the beasts doubtless hastening their decision. In vain did Messrs. Rowe, Belford and LaVan protest, offering every money inducement if they force their horses back on the wharf. "Not much, said one of the burly drivers, I'm working for a transfer company, I'm no animal keeper. I'm afraid of the beasts and that's honest." This seemed to voice the opinion of the other drivers and quit they did in a body. Well sir, said Mr. Rowe, with a twinkle in his eye, I lost the entire day trying to induce local teamsters to handle the consignment but when they learned the character of the haul, some shook their heads, some refused flatly and some hurried away, evidently on pressing business, and all this time we had to feed and care for the beasts for we did not dare leave the wharf for fear some of the collection would get out. Finally we had to wire our men in San Jose to hurry on with our animal wagons from the winter quarters and when they finally did make their appearance, we were wet, cold and hungry and gladly hurried home after the live freight was duly loaded. Next time this show buys any wild animals, said Mr. Rowe, it will take its own teams to transfer them, no matter what the expense. The Norris & Rowe circus is in the city today.

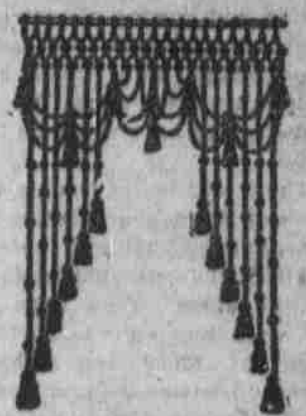

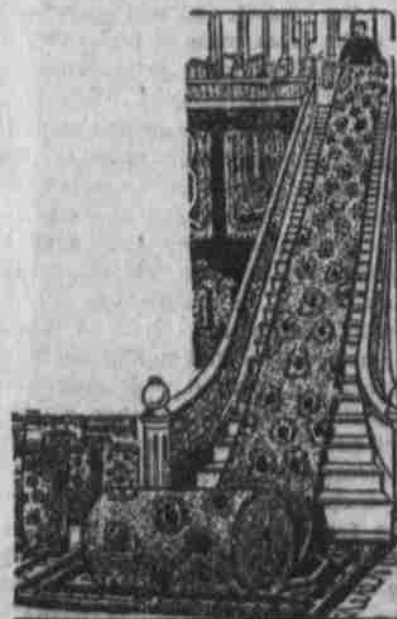
