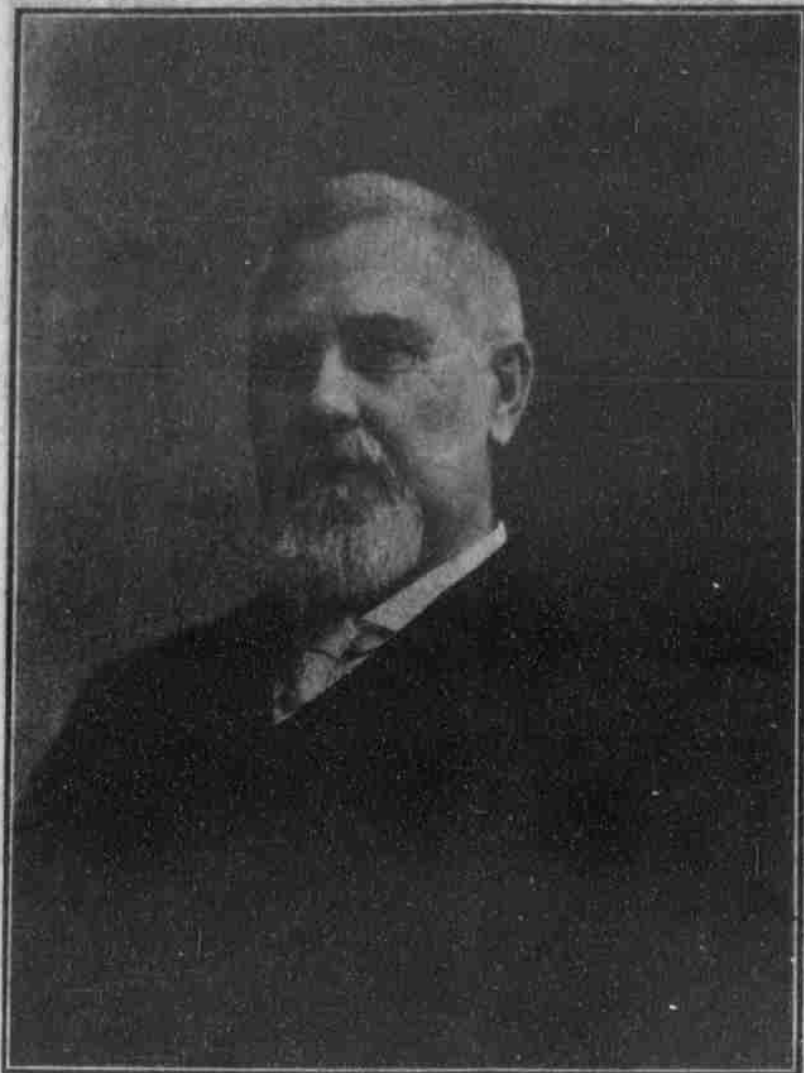


**HON. J. H. SETTLE-

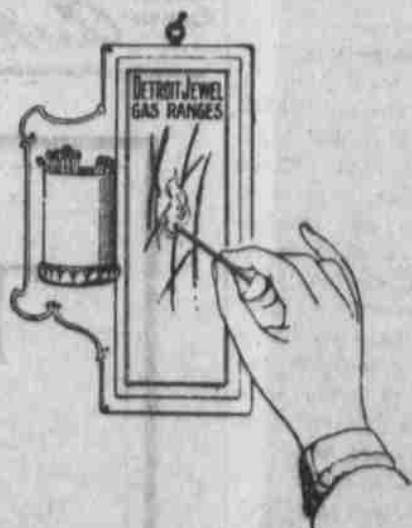
