

HELEN MORTON'S DUKE

Seeking Separation From the Daughter of the Vice President

New York, June 7.—The sudden news that the Duke and Duchess Valencay are preparing to sever the marriage relations in a Paris court created surprise in society. The duchess was formerly Helen Morton, daughter of the erstwhile vice-president and governor. The couple, it is learned, has been separated for some time. At the time of their marriage, four years ago, the Mortons settled \$30,000 yearly on the daughter.

Boiled Down.

The Pacific Mail freighter Alcoa struck a ledge of rocks at Point Bonita this morning, tearing a great hole in her side. She got off without assistance, and reached her wharf with 13 feet of water in her forward peak. The cargo is badly damaged.

In Paris the foreign office denies a current report that the French Mediterranean squadron has been ordered to Tangiers.

At Newport, R. I., a Holland submarine, after 12 hours' of submergence with her crew, came to the surface, at 11 o'clock this morning. The test was declared satisfactory.

A waterspout struck Enloe, Texas, today, and half a mile of the Texas-Midland track was washed away. Hundreds of acres of cotton are inundated and citizens are forced to seek refuge in tree tops. The livestock loss is heavy.

The Manchester fire loss is \$260,000.
