# OFFICIAL COUNT FINISHED

Figures Give Republicans the Greatest Plurality Ever Known in State

The official count of the late election was announced Saturday evening. The final totals increase the state majorities several hundred votes, State Food and Dairy Commissioner Bailey leading the list with 24,283 plurality. The count is as follows:

The printer amendment failed to carry, not receiving the necessary majority of all votes cast at the election, it being a constitutional amendment and not under the same provisions as the other questions voted on. Governor Chamberlain issued proclamations today declaring direct primary and local option laws a part of the code and they will be in force on and after this date.
