MOVE DOWN TOWN

Street Car Barns Will Be
Located Near Willamette
Hotel

The office and car barns of the Citizens' Light & Traction Company will be moved within a short time to the Bush building, south of the Willamette hotel. The change will enable the officials of the company to keep in closer touch with the employees, and will be a great saving of time and trouble.

All the car lines center at or near the hotel, and when a car gives out on any of the lines it will be more convenient to send one from the barn than it is at present.

The entrance to the building will be made up Ferry street to the alley in the rear of the hotel, and thence through the alley to the east end of the building.

The offices will be arranged in the front part of the block, and will be equipped in an up-to-date style. The new company is not saying much, but they are certainly doing things. Let the good work go on, and within a short time Salem will have the best electric car and light service of any city in the state.

Iceless Refrigerator.

The Roseburg Plaindealer gives the following description of an iceless refrigerator: Build a wooden frame the size you wish your refrigerator, making brackets for shelves, then cover the frame with ordinary burlap, making the top double thickness. The side to be used for a door can be left open on one side or a swinging frame door covered with burlap may be used, then take an ordinary coal oil can and punch a hole in each side near the bottom of the can and insert wooden plugs so that the dripping of water may be regulated, then fill the can with water place it on top of the frame, regulate the flow of water and your refrigerator is complete. A model built at Roseburg was placed in the sun and started working and a plate of soft lard placed on the shelf. Within an hour the lard was solid and hard as if it had been kept on ice for a month. This is something which can be built with little expense.

Briggs, Sr. was at home, and the young man, approaching, said: "Well, dad, I don't think I'll roll any more rock for you."

"I guess you will if you stay around here," retorted the senior member of the sketch, somewhat surprised at this aspect of mutiny.

"No, I don't think I shall, come back from the youth. Look at this will you," as he drew from his pockets two handfuls of the stuff from which is made the root of all evil.

"Where did you get that?" gasped Mr. Briggs.

"Never mind," answered the youngster, tearfully, "there's plenty more where that came from," and a little later he took the father to the place where the sack of gold was hidden. He has rolled no more stones in his father's placer diggings.

The family is now independent. All of \$30,000 has already been taken from the ledge, and the quartz is wonderful to behold. Philip S. Bates, editor of the Pacific Miner, has two pieces of sample quartz, sent to him by A. L. Mooris, who owns a claim on the same ledge 2200 feet from the Briggs claim. The gold in these pieces of quartz stand out plainly to be seen by the naked eye. One piece no larger than a child's fist contains \$75 worth of the precious metal. The gold is carried in what is known among miners as rotten porphyry.—Roseburg Plaindealer.
