Substitute for Constitutional Convention Bill

Shall Thirty Members of That Convention Be Appointed by the Supreme Court

There is a general sentiment in favor of a new constitution in Oregon, but the first step taken to submit a bill or a constitutional convention an issue is raised by the lawyers of the state senate that threatens to defeat needed reforms that could be accomplished by the construction of a new constitution.

- To allow the governor to veto single items of any appropriation bill. To allow the state printer to be placed on a salary. To allow cities to make and amend their own charters.

The substitute bill for a constitutional convention, reported favorably by the judiciary committee of the state senate, provides that the constitutional convention shall be held at Salem, Oregon, on the 15th day of November, 1906, and that it shall contain 90 members, 30 of them from the state at large, chosen by the supreme court, and 60 by the electors of the state.

The apportionment of the 60 is to be as follows:

Thinks This Legislature Is Not Social

Ed. Journal: I have spent a few more days at the capital as an observer at the halls of legislation, and can say I can now more fully realize what a fool I was making of myself a few years ago when I was a member.

The lobbyists seem to have more money than the members, and are staying at the hotels, except the railroad magnates, who stay in their private car.

I notice the usual talk about railroad passes among the members. When I was in the house a few years ago each member got a pass for the session, and could get a trip ticket from one of the big railroad lawyers when they were up at Salem, looking after legislation. But it was generally confined to the man's wife or daughter. Now I see they are using a great many for their whole family and friends.

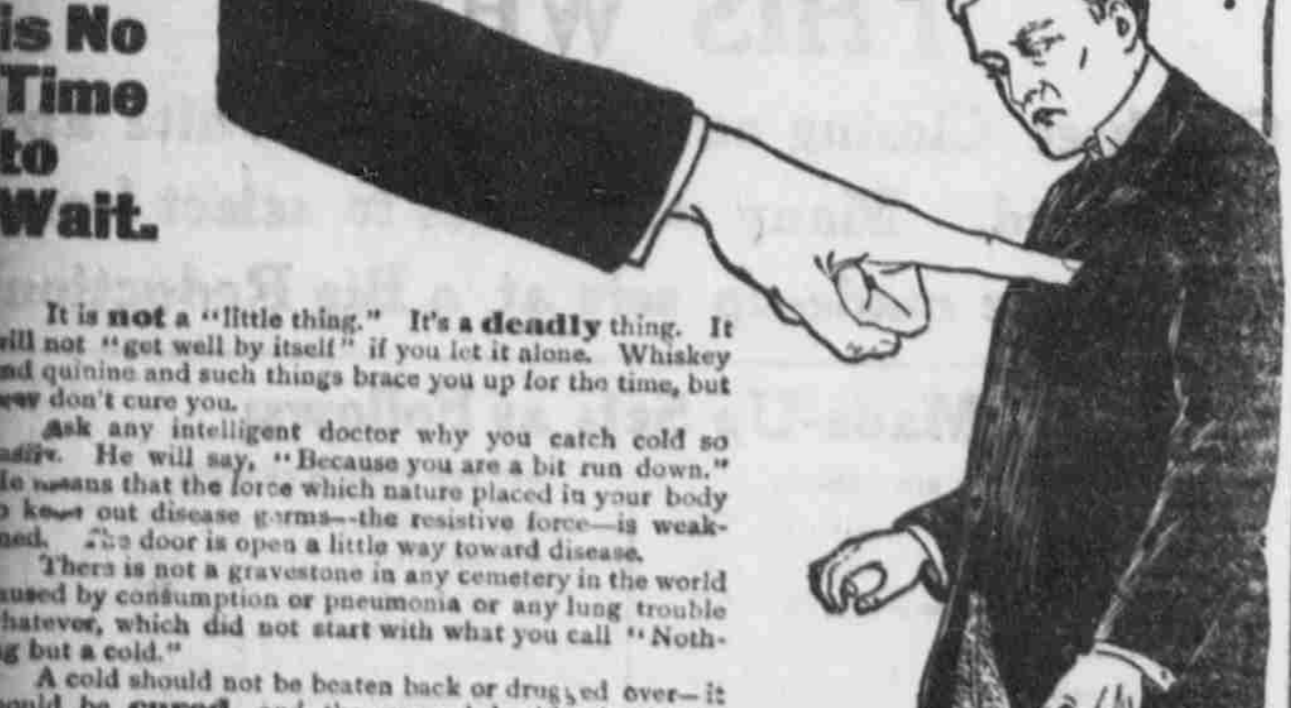
