

## JUDGES CANNOT LIMIT

### Argument to Less Than Two Hours and Instructions Must Be Written

Richie could not see much merit in a senate bill to limit the judges in time for argument, and objected to extending the time for speeches to two hours. The bill provided that the lawyers might take at least two hours if they wished. He approved of the feature, that of written instructions. It would prevent confusion. Muir of Multnomah was of the opinion that this was a good bill. Judges sometimes abused their privilege in writing debate and giving instructions.

Kay of Marion said it was a question at times which was the most arbitrary, the judge or the attorneys. It was unusual for a judge to be arbitrary in these matters. He thought the jury was entitled to protection as well as the clients, and there was as much danger of abuse on the part of the lawyers as of the judge.

West of Tillamook said he favored the bill, as he believed a lawyer should earn his money.

Linthicum explained the last provision of the bill, which required that the charge to the jury should be in writing when either party requested it. The jury could then take these written charges to the jury room and not be obliged to remember the oral comments and instructions of the court. He said his bill tried to place it beyond the power of any judge to be arbitrary in writing counsel.

Smith of Josephine was sure that the judge should be allowed to cut off a lawyer in his right to fully present a case on behalf of his client. The bill went to a vote and the record stood: Ayes 52, nays 5.

The votes against the bill were Caldwell, Calvert, Kay, Richie and Stiemler.
