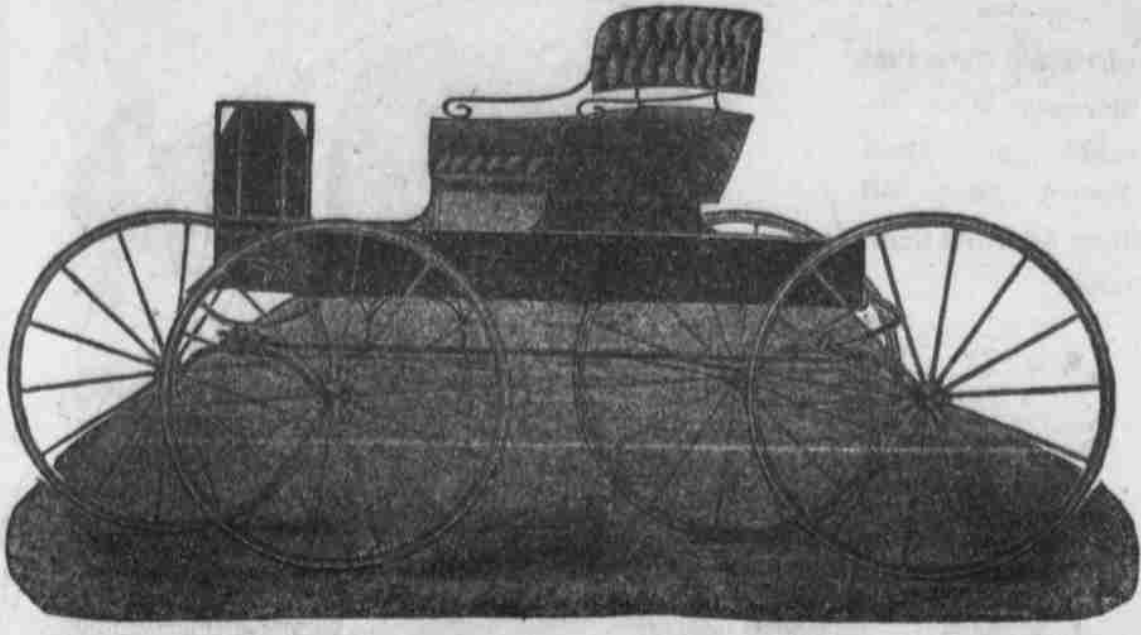

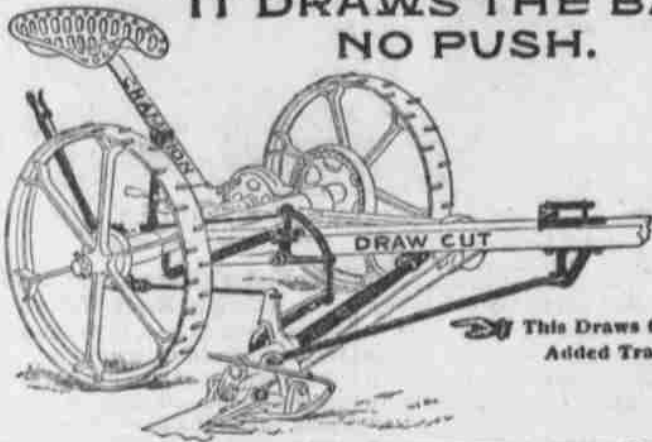

The Champion draw-cut mower is equipped with ball and roller bearings of a late and improved pattern. The cutters may be raised high from the ground, either by a foot lever or a hand lever, as the driver may prefer. The machine is nicely balanced, without weight on the horses' necks. If the driver is large, and the tongue will not stay down in front, the seat may be moved forward until the balance is exact.

Among the many improvements found on the Champion Rakes, that of the most value is the locking device for holding down the teeth of the horse-dump rake when gathering. This is why it is called a lock-lever rake. In ordinary raking the teeth of the Champion remain down themselves, conforming to any unevenness of the ground, and, besides, they may be held down as easily by a foot lever as on any other hay rake; nevertheless, when raking very heavy hay, or when bunching, or when a boy is driving it is a great advantage to lock the teeth down.

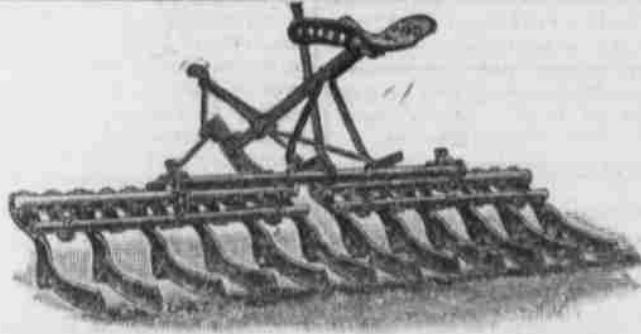

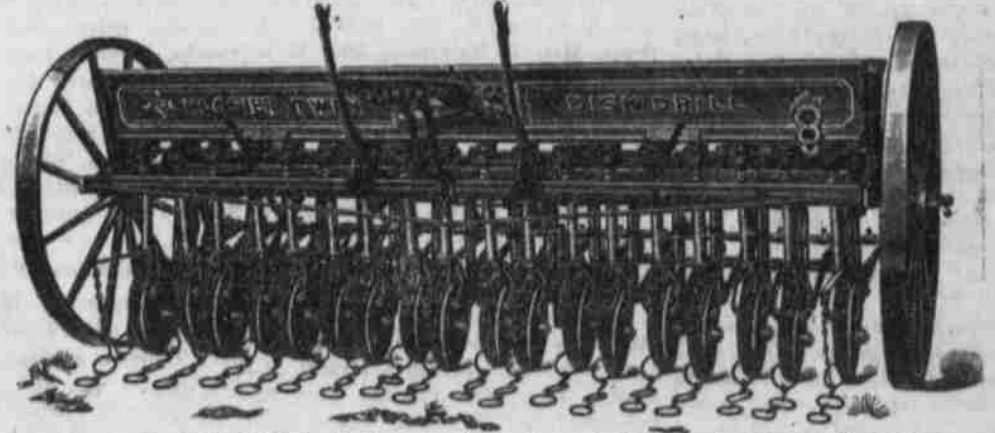

Linn county threshing machine owners are going to hold a meeting at Beeds on June 17th to fix prices for threshing and wages to be paid to laborers.

Two sons of Fred Cooper, of Watachee, Wash., were killed by lightning Thursday. Several children with whom they were playing were stunned, but none seriously injured.

A complaint has been filed against the city of Corvallis enjoining said city from paying for a survey and estimate of costs in the matter of a survey of a water route from Corvallis to Rock creek.

More berries are being sent out from Hood River this season than were shipped last year, notwithstanding a 10 per cent decrease in the total acreage. This is accounted for by the superior quality of the berries this year.

Invasion of the local crab fishing by Portland men, composing the Standard Crab company, is causing considerable ill feeling among the more heavily equipped Yaquina fishermen, and the "peta" of the outside concern have been cut and were nearly carried to sea. The Standard people are now guarding the outfit carefully.

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the superintendent of the Oregon State Penitentiary, at Salem, Oregon, until Thursday, June 22, 1905, at 1 o'clock p. m., of said day, for the labor of the convicts confined in said penitentiary, under the provisions of an act of the legislature passed in 1895, and amendments thereto, and for the foundry plant belonging to the state, and situated within the prison walls. Bids to be made separately on the basis of a five or a ten-year lease, beginning August 1, 1905, on blanks which will be forwarded by the superintendent on application.

Each bidder must enclose with his bid a certified check in the sum of \$500 payable to the order of the Superintendent, to be forfeited to the State in case the bidder to which the contract is let fails to enter into a contract, and give the bond required by the statute within ten days after the awarding of the contract.
