Then the older people cut amazing capers, shouted themselves hourse and made the most repulsive faces you ever saw by way of welcome to their chief. Chairs were put for us on the veranda of the whare, which was prettily decorated with beautiful palms,

After some time of this and the pres entation of mats, etc., we were invited into the whare to lunch. It was laid most correctly on big tables with cloths but the menu consisted of roast duck, chicken, beef and sucking pig and, so it is said, potatoes, peas and knemaros (sweet potatoes), cooked in a Maori oven. I chose cold duck, with peas and potatoes. The duck arrived quickly, but the Maori girl who brought it said with broad smiles, :: The pots. | largest and best newspaper press toes aren't cooked yet!'' So my lunch consisted of duck, bread and two oranges. Just as I finished the potatoes arrived in pretty plaited green flax baskets.
