HAS THE STATE LAND BOARD ANY JURISDICTION OVER FRAUDS?

The question whether the board shall cancel the certificates held by DeLaitre and his associates was before the board, but the attorneys for both sides agreed that the board has no such power.

It must have been pleasant, at least to the lawyers who represent the claimants under alleged fraudulent certificates, to have such an agreement reached.

That it will not be a good policy for the state land board to adopt the plan of repudiating state land certificates obtained by fraud, is the opinion expressed by Attorney General Crawford in his argument before the board in the De Laitre case.

that the board has power to direct him to bring suit in the courts to secure cancellation of the certificate, the same as an individual may bring suit to cancel a contract obtained by fraud.

According to this theory it makes no difference how much apparent fraud there may be in the application for school land, the state officials must act in a merely clerical capacity and promote what appears to their plain view to be a fraud on the face of the filing.

The attorney general admitted that if the state land board brings suit to cancel certificates of sale, it must tender return of money paid. He doubted whether it would be wise for the state, from a financial standpoint, to cancel the sales and return the money, for, in many instances the price received is as much as the land is worth.

It seems to The Capital Journal that the argument that the state has received "as much as the land is worth" is not a good argument, if any fraud was practiced to obtain the land from the state.

Railroad, Industrial and Financial Notes.

A contract has been let for the construction of the Atlantic, Birmingham & Atlantic line from La Grange, Ga., to Talladega, Ala.

The Northern Pacific road announces that it will positively construct the promised extension of its line from Oull-de-Sac, Idaho, thirty miles southeast to Grangeville, near Mount Idaho.

The American Rio Grande Land & Irrigation company has been chartered in Texas. It plans to place 125,000 acres of land situated in the valley of the Rio Grande under irrigation.

Evidence of prosperity in all parts of Colorado are shown by the present scarcity of labor in many lines. Railroads, ranches, mining and manufacturing interests are reported in need of more men and good wages go begging just now.

The Jamestown, Dixie & Cherry Valley Railroad company has been organized at Batesville, Ark. The company proposes to construct a line from Jamestown to Cherry Valley, a distance of sixty-five miles.

It is officially announced that the Grand Trunk Pacific Railroad company has given an order for \$4,000,000 worth of steel rails to the Dominion Iron & Steel company. The contract calls for the delivery of the rails within five years.
