

machine, a prominent merchant of Salem brought his young daughter to be treated for a ruptured blood vessel of the face. The method of treatment was interesting.

#### A Treatment.

After placing the little mist on the operating table, her face was covered with a sheet of lead one-sixteenth of an inch thick. In this piece of lead was left a hole just large enough to cover the spot to be treated. The rays will not go through lead that is one-thirty-second of an inch thick or more, and that is the reason this metal is used as a face covering. If the lead were not used, the rays, while killing the diseased tissue, would also burn the healthy tissue and destroy the hair follicles.

The doctor then fitted a glass globe to the machine. In this globe were two platinum electrodes, fitted in a vacuum—that is, the air had been exhausted, but a quantity of gas had been left in the globe. When the electric current was turned on 40,000 volts were developed in this globe. The action of the electricity caused a chemical ray of a violet color to flow from one electrode to the other, and in the globe it could be seen that one half was entirely filled with these violet, or X-Rays, while the other half had some of them. The rays from the first half of the globe were directed through the hole in the lead sheet, and for several minutes were allowed to do their healing work. After the rays were turned off, the treatment was over for the time, without pain or suffering of any kind to the patient, who was perfectly conscious through it all.

#### Treating Internal Cancer.

This is the manner in which external cancer and other skin diseases are treated. For internal diseases the method employed is different. As the epidermis is the densest portion of the body, any rays that will pass through and not be absorbed by it will pass through the entire body and out on the other side. It is necessary to modify the rays so that they will be absorbed by the diseased tissue to be treated. This cannot be done with internal cancer unless a surgical operation is first performed. One

prominent case of internal cancer of recent days is interesting in this connection.

Everyone has read of the case of President Harper, of Chicago University, who was given up to die of cancer. But Dr. Harper did not die. He still holds his connection with the university. His physicians decided to treat him with the X-Ray. They used the knife to make an opening through the flesh until the cancer was revealed. The X-Ray was then turned onto the cancer. The wound was kept open for some time, while additional treatments were given, and President Harper's life was saved. It may require some further treatment in his case, but physicians hope for an ultimate complete cure. This method of treatment can be followed in most cases of internal cancer.

#### How Photographs Are Taken.

In taking photographs with the X-Ray the person to be photographed is placed on the table, with the photographic plate placed under the part of the body to be reproduced on the photograph. The X-Ray is then turned on, and fifteen seconds' exposure will give a picture of the interior of the body through clothing and flesh. They have a collection in their office of photographs that they have taken in this way since coming to Salem.

These physicians not only use this wonderful X-Ray in treating their own patients, but they also treat the cases which other physicians often bring to them. In addition to this work, Drs. Dalton and Clay have established a complete laboratory for bacteriological work, and for microscopic and chemical analyses, and many physicians avail themselves of this feature in diagnosing the cases that come to them in their practice. Dr. Dalton has had a special training for this class of work, and holds the chair at the medical college of Willamette University for this subject.
