### Mme. Ristori's Birthday.

Rome, Jan. 29.—Adelaide Ristori, the famous Italian tragedy queen, is celebrating her 84th birthday today, and all Italy paid homage to the venerable artist. Letters and telegrams of congratulation arrived for her from all parts of the world, and with them many rare and costly presents from her admirers, who are scattered all over the globe. Many of the letters and gifts came from America.

In the evening there will be a special performance in honor of the tragedienne at the Tatro della Valle. All fashionable Rome will be present and many of the most distinguished dignitaries of the city will sit with Mme. Ristori and other members of her family in her loge. The most famous actors of Rome will take part in the performance, which will be in the nature of an ovation for the great actress, now Marquise del Grillo. The many beautiful gifts received by the tragedienne will be exhibited on the stage. Mme. Ristori was born at Cividale, Italy. On her first appearance in Paris in 1855 she was harshly criticized for posing as the rival of Rachel, then at the height of her fame. Ristori won popular favor, however, and everywhere, especially in the United States, she was received with enthusiasm. Among her leading parts were Francesca di Rimini, Maria Stuart, Pia del Tolomei, Myrrha, Phaedra, Judith and Lady Macbeth. The last character she played in America with Edwin Booth. She retired from the English stage in 1873, but has since then appeared in Italy on several occasions.

Those Jews who are not Zionists and persons who are not Jews, but sympathize with the oppressed Jews in Russia, are urged to purchase a Terumat, which also cost 25 cents apiece, but confer no rights or privileges, but are merely tokens of the owner's sympathy with the oppressed or with the work of the Zionists.
