The K. of C. Affair.

New York, Feb. 5.—One of the biggest Roman Catholic affairs of the year in this city is the annual charity ball and drill which the Knights of Columbus gives at Madison Square Garden every winter. This year's ball promises to surpass all former events of that kind in brilliancy and popular success. The Catholics of this city have manifested the greatest enthusiasm for the event, and never has been the bidding for boxes as brisk and were the prices realized as high as this year. The number of distinguished guests who will be present at Madison Square Garden this evening will be unusually large. President Roosevelt and Governor Higgins and staff had been invited, but were compelled to decline; the President because his duties in connection with the session of congress did not permit him to leave Washington at this time; Governor Higgins, because he had cancelled all social engagements because of the recent death of Mrs. Higgins' mother. However, the President will be represented by Rear Admiral Joseph B. Coghlan, commandant of the Brooklyn navy yard and his staff, while Governor Higgins will be represented by Secretary of State John F. O'Brien.

Archbishop Farley, as head of the Roman Catholic church of this city, will be the reviewing officer of the Fourth Degree corps, a uniformed body, which will give an interesting drill during the evening. An innovation this year will be the participation of the First regiment of Knights of Columbus of Brooklyn. The music for the drill will be furnished by a band of 250 musicians under the leadership of Sir Knights James Beggs and Thomas R. Ward.

Preparing for Lipton Cup Race.

Chicago, Feb. 5.—F. H. Price and George R. Pearce, representing the Chicago Athletic club syndicate, have ordered a new yacht from the collaborated design of Morgan Barney and Charles D. Mower of New York for the race for the Lipton cup, which is to be sailed on Lake Michigan, near Chicago, on August 18, 20 and 21. The race will be sailed under the direction of the Columbia Yacht club.

The race is confined to 21 foot boats of the great lakes and the class is restricted so far as water line and over all lengths are concerned, but in other details and in the sail area a more liberal hand within certain limitations is allowed. Five other boats from as many designers are also on the way with the same end in view. The Barney-Vower boat will be built in the east and shipped to its destination upon completion in the spring. She will be sailed in the race by Mr. Pearce, who is considered one of the best of the many capable Corinthians on the lakes.

The cup was won last year and the year before by the St. Claire, owned by members of the Detroit Country club, and the interest in the race is considerably increasing as the time for the event approaches. Recently the deed of gift for the cup was amended so as to allow any yacht of the 21 foot class, regularly enrolled in a bona fide yacht club of the great lakes or their tributaries to compete without time allowance. Heretofore only yachts belonging to an association which is a member of the Yacht Racing union of the great lakes could take part in the competitions.
