## STORY OF LIEN CHOW

Manila, P. I., March 19.—Troubled conditions in China are perhaps a greater source of solicitude here than they are among the people of the United States, and the massacre of the Presbyterian missionaries last fall at Lien Chow made a profound impression here, not only among the church people of Manila, but among all American and European residents.

The deep interest was made manifest when a memorial service for the murdered missionaries was held in the First Presbyterian church of Manila a few days ago. The temporary chapel used by the congregation was crowded to the doors, and although additional chairs were brought in, filling all available space, many had to stand throughout the service. It was the largest

gathering ever assembled in the Manila Presbyterian church.

The story of Lien Chow was told by the Rev. Lewis R. Hillis; and the Rev. Dr. Stealy B. Rossiter, the Presbyterian pastor of the North Presbyterian church of New York, made a stirring address on the justification of foreign missions. An offering was made to help in the reconstruction of the Lien Chow mission buildings. The Presbyterians of Manila express themselves as greatly pleased that the board of foreign missions refused to ask indemnity for the death of its missionaries. As Dr. Rossiter states the feeling: "We are proud to know that our blood is not measured by money value. All missionaries here, and I doubt not all in this Oriental field, feel a willingness to die for the Lord's cause if need be, but we want the full valuation of the sacrifice, and that would be diminished by an indemnity. If die we must, let us have the full glory of the martyr's crown."

Work is about to be commenced on the new chapel of the First Presbyterian church, which it is hoped to complete before the end of the year. Many are urging that the main church should also be commenced at once.

## WORLD'S OCEAN CABLES

Altogether Germany has over 18,816 miles of cables, of which, however, only about 3293 are owned by the government. The total cable length of the earth is between 273,402 and 279,616 miles, from which will be seen that Germany's percentage is, notwithstanding all the progress which has been made in the last year in that direction, very modest. Really, only about one-fifteenth of the total cable length is German, while England has more than two-thirds. Not more than two years ago, however, Germany's part was no more than one-twentieth, so it is evident that since that time Germany has made great strides forward. The newly laid cable from Shanghai to Yap is especially remarkable for the reason that a continuous line of cable has been laid around the whole earth which is not English.

From Europe to East Asia and the Chinese coast there are the land telegraphs and sea cables of the Danish Great Norse Telegraph company. The Atlantic ocean is traversed not only by the English telegraph lines, but also by the American, French and German cables. These are, through the various service lines of the United States, combined with the western coast of America, and from San Francisco the American Pacific cable extends via Guam to the Philippines. In Guam however, the German-Netherlands cable system branches off to Yap, from which place the new cable has made a new bond of union with the German and Danish lines on the Chinese coast. The cable Shanghai-Yap assures to Germany henceforth a telegraphic union with the Ladrones and Caroline islands independent of English influence, and these islands are German colonial possessions, besides also the union with the Great Sunda Islands and the important Dutch colonial possessions in farther India, which are so important also for the German commerce.

The Shanghai-Yap cable line has been laid in greater sea depths than any other cable. Up to a few years ago there was no cable in a greater depth than 16,404 feet. The American cable in the Pacific ocean was in 1903 laid in depths to 20,469 feet. The cable Menado-Yap-Guam, which was laid in the year 1905 by the German cable steamer Stephan, surpassed this record, inasmuch as it was obliged to lay the cable in depths of 22,966 feet, and to lay the cable Shanghai-Yap, which work was also the task of the cable steamer Stephan. It was even necessary in the vicinity of Liuku islands to reach depths of 26,246.90 feet, which is one of the deepest places to be found anywhere in the ocean. The cable was manufactured in Germany in the North German Sea Cable works in Nordenham, at the mouth of the Weser.—Consul Lisfeld of Frieberg, Germany.

The efforts of the Japanese to introduce their piece goods in this market demand serious attention. With their cheap labor and low freight rates they are enabled to sell 14-pound cotton goods, measuring thirty-six inches by forty yards, 40 cents per piece lower than their competitors. It is declared here by the Chinese that the manufacturers of Japan are producing an excellent quality, which compares favorably with the piece goods now popular in the market, and if they can make other weights at correspondingly low prices they will eventually be able to take a commanding position in the piece goods trade. The native Chinese are also manufacturing in immense quantities cloths for wearing apparel from yarn imported from

India. They use the hand looms, and, as in central and northern China, these looms may be found in a large majority of the homes. They are worked by the women of the household and, beyond the price of the yarn, there is no expense attached to the manufacture. It is also regarded as only a question of time when the Chinese will see the advantage of operating their own mills for the manufacture of cloths. They profess to believe that when the time arrives the native consumers, animated by the newly aroused national spirit, will patronize home industries to the exclusion as far as possible of foreign-made goods.
