Two rings or whistles signify to lower cage, and three rings or whistles signify that the men are coming up; when the return signal is received from the engineer the men get on the cage and the cager rings or whistles Four rings or whistles signify to beist slowly, implying danger.

Five rings or whistles signify an accident in the mine and call for a strotcher.

Six rings or whistles call for a reversal of the fam.

From top to bottom, one ring or whistle signifies, all ready, get on cage, and two rings or whistles signify, send away empty cage.-Engineering and Mining Journal.
