WHAT HAPPENED WHEN SONORA TRIED TO ANNEX CALIFORNIA

Sonora, the seat of the recent war between Americans and Mexicans, has been a disturbing center ever since the American conquest of California.

It was from Sonora that Flores, a guerrilla, came with a band of bandits and raised the "standard of revolt," after California had passed into possession of the Americans.

The most noted invasion, or filibustering expedition was partly inaugurated by an "exile" for Sonora, and, strangely, the cause originated from the Pesqueria mine.

After his marriage with the pretty Filomena, he organized a company of filibusters for the purpose of establishing a republic in Sonora, and also to recover the valuable mines of his

father-in-law, which had been confiscated by Gov. Pesqueria. At that time, the question of dividing California into two states was a live issue.

Thus, Crabb was actuated by both the promise of fame and wealth, in restoring the bonanza mines to his father-in-law. Ainz and his friends furnished the funds, and in the spring of 1855 Crabb left for Sonora with 250 mounted men.

A few years prior to this Rouse de Boulbon led an expedition from San Francisco against Sonora. This was however, in the interest of France, as that government desired a foothold in Mexico.

Mexicans. The defeated filibusters surrendered, and nearly all of them were shot at sunrise next morning in violation of the articles of surrender.

The attempt of the French government to gain a foothold in Mexico was renewed a decade later, when our government was busy with a revolution of its own, but the attempt failed, with similar tragic results.

The latest attempt of Americans to acquire Sonora was in the sixties but it was by the more peaceable plan of colonization. Former United States Senator W. M. Gwin, one of the most noted politicians of California, obtained a concession from the Mexican government to an immense area of land both agricultural and mineral.

HOW THEY VOTED.

On Local Option in Benton and Other Counties. (Corvallis Times.)

In the last election Benton county went dry by 20 more votes than in the original election of two years ago. The majority for drouth was 286, against 266 formerly. The total number of votes cast for prohibition was 1040, against 754.

The precincts that went dry in the late election and the majorities each gave are: Corvallis No. 1, 61; Corvallis No. 2, 17; Corvallis No. 3, 16; Philomath, 129; Soap Creek, 9; Alsea, 29; Willamette, 7; Bellfountain, 47.

Since the result of the election in Linn county became known, many of those in Corvallis who are opposed to dry conditions are far better satisfied than formerly.

RATES. Newport, Yaquina Bay, Breitenbush Hot Springs from All S. P. and C. & E. Points.

S. P. trains connect with the C. & E. at Albany and Corvallis for Yaquina and Newport. Trains on the C. & E. for Detroit will leave Albany at 7:30 a. m., enabling tourists to the Hot Springs to reach there the same day. Trains from and to Corvallis connect with all East Side trains on the S. P.
