

CONVICT BUILT ROADS

TO BE EXTENDED SOUTH WITH AID FROM COUNTY

Governor Chamberlain's Offer Accepted by Marion County

The business men of Salem are deeply interested not only in the extension of electric lines into the Santiam country, but they are vitally concerned that the first-class highway now built to the state reform school shall be extended to Turner and on to the towns south and east.

There is no reason why the convict-built road shall not be extended on to Marion, Jefferson, Albany and Eugene, and east to Aumsville, Sublimity, Stayton and Mehama. That kind of road can be constructed cheaper than any other, and the convict-built roads are the best in the state, so far constructed.

The cost to the county need not be over \$4200 per mile, and the cost to the state need not be over that amount. That is the cheapest way in the world to construct public highways, the convicts doing the heavy work and the state and counties sharing in the other necessary expenses. When roads can be obtained so cheaply, they should be built in all directions.

Governor Chamberlain's offer to extend the convict-built highways on to Turner, and then still further on as fast as means can be had to do the work, if the county will take charge and keep up the convict-built road already constructed, is a fair proposition. If he said the opposite, that he would not build another inch until the county did keep in repair what has already been built, nobody could blame him. He has built five miles of as fine road as there is in the county, and it should be put in repair for the winter and covered with a coating of crushed rock as soon as possible. To all this the county court expressed themselves favorably. An order will be made at this term of court that will result in that fine highway being kept in perfect order, and at small expense, and as soon as possible putting on a fine coating of crushed rock on the road. If that is provided for, the governor says he will extend the model highway built by the state, and in fact it should be extended to Albany and Mehama as fast as possible. The subscription plan is too slow. Convict work, with county aid, is the quickest way to secure good roads.

The editor of The Capital Journal went before the Marion county commissioners' court and explained the condition of the convict-built road from this city to the state reform school, and the offer of Governor Chamberlain to extend that road to Turner if the county would assume the care of the road already built, and of any road the state may construct with convict labor. The court seemed very favorable to the proposition, and members of the court stated some action would be taken. They seemed to think it difficult to get the best result unless there was one person directed to look after it, as the road lies in several districts, and it is probable the county road engineer will be directed to look after it. The commissioners expressed themselves in favor of cleaning the road of rock, repairing low places and dragging it perfectly smooth. The scarcity of fuel at Salem compels the hauling of nearly all the cordwood of that part of the country, and there will be heavy traffic on that piece of road all winter.
