Letter to School Children.

Chicago, Dec. 4, 1906.

The fourth day across the continent landed us in Chicago. Twelve hours is required to cross Iowa and Illinois, from Omaha on the Missouri river to Chicago on Lake Michigan. About all you see is corn fields, towns, cities, hogs, cattle and corn-crisps full of yellow corn. Iowa and Illinois are considered the two richest farming states in the Mississippi valley. They are well watered, have immense beds of coal near the surface, rich soil and plenty of timber along the streams. There are no pine, spruce, cedar or fir trees—all oak, maple, elm, ash, willow and nut trees.

The Mississippi is a great stream, navigable for steamboats to St. Paul. A canal has been built from Chicago across the state of Illinois to the Mississippi river. It is called a drainage canal, because it drains Lake Michigan into the Father of Waters. It is proposed to make this a deep-water canal from Chicago to St. Louis. Great deep-draught vessels will go from the Lakes down to St. Louis and New Orleans, and through the Panama canal, when it is built, to Portland, Oregon. The delegates from Illinois to the rivers and harbors congress all went to Washington to labor for this canal. All the great farming states are working for better transportation.

City House Cleaning.

The Springfield Republican recently contained an editorial descriptive of the city house cleaning efforts of the local organizations which are affiliated with the American Civic association, in which it made the following comments:

"Once upon a time all reforms began in the east and swept onward toward the wild west, which wasn't supposed to know it needed reforming. Now the order of things is reversed. Take the subject of city house cleaning. Boston and New York look dirty as they like to feel pleased to have it so; it is Denver, Chicago, Grand Rapids, Kalamazoo, and New Orleans that have a regular spring cleaning on a day set by the mayor, when streets, alleys, back yards and sidewalks are cleaned, together with any other thing of the kind that needs it. Denver a year ago, at the call of Mayor Speer, thoroughly cleaned all its downtown streets and alleys, painted all poles used in its fire and police systems, placed new and improved refuse cans at street and alley crossings, and private citizens looked over their own property and neighborhood, to the great improvement in health, orderliness and taste. Mayor Dunne, of Chicago, selected May 7, and called upon householders to gather up tin cans and other rubbish at the end of each lot in readiness for garbage collectors to take it to the dump; he requested school principals and teachers to get the school boys to clean up the vacant lots; fifty policemen were appointed to remind householders of the city regulations concerning the disposal of waste; the superintendent of streets organized his men so that the whole city was served with collecting wagons to take away rubbish."
