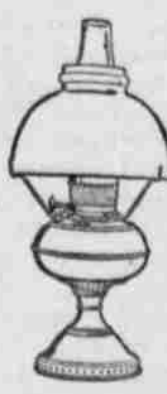

IRISHMEN DISCUSS HOME RULES

Dublin, Dec. 14.—The draft of the home rule bill submitted by Sir Anthony McDowell was discussed at a large and representative meeting of Irishmen in the Rotunda tonight. Mr. John Redmond, M. P., presided. The new bill proposes to leave the legislative union untouched, and an Irish council is to be created with a proportion of between two-thirds and three-fourths of its members elected on the existing parliamentary franchise, the remainder to be elected on a restricted franchise or nominated at the same time; this country is to retain her present representation in the imperial parliament. Clergymen of all denominations are eligible for membership in the council. The new administration will be as follows: The central or estate board, a department of education, a department of agriculture, a department of land transfer. The police are to remain under imperial control, but are to be reduced in numbers, and the position of the judiciary is to remain unaffected. It is computed that after deduction from Irish tax revenue for imperial purposes \$25,000,000 a year will remain at the disposal of the Irish council. Mr. John Dillon, M. P., denounced the clauses under which the police are to remain under the direction of the imperial government, and Mr. Michael Flavin, M. P.; Mr. Haviland Burke, M. P.; Mr. S. Green, M. P., and others spoke against the formation of the central council or estate board. It is certain that when the bill is introduced in the house it will be productive of great heat, as the people of the north of Ireland and their parliamentary representatives are wholly opposed to it.

New Railroad to Wyoming Mines.

Cheyenne, Wyo., Dec. 14.—In a day or two the Saratoga & Encampment Railway company will commence the construction of a line from Walleot, through Saratoga and Wyoming to the Grand Encampment mining district of this state. The road is being backed by the Pennsylvania-Wyoming Copper company, and will be used by them to place their ore on the market. The road will also receive the benefit of large ore shipments from the Portland Copper Mining company's mines, which are located near the town of Grand Encampment.

Power From Victoria Falls.

London, Dec. 14.—The Victoria Falls Power company at its first meeting today announced that all capital required was subscribed. The company proposes to transmit electricity generated at Victoria falls to Pretoria and Johannesburg. The distance from the falls to the Rand as the crow flies is 600 miles, but it will be necessary to make deviations that will increase the distance to be covered to nearly 700 miles. The extraordinary pressure of 10,000 volts is proposed.

Nuts Scarce in Eastern States.

Buffalo, Dec. 14.—There is a remarkable scarcity of all kinds of nuts this season, and from present indications prices are bound to soar, as the shipments from Italy are far below the average. Fancy shell hickory nuts, big hullnuts and chestnuts are in great demand.
