When a car or cars are applied for under the provisions of this act and are not furnished as herein required. the railroad so failing to furnish such cars shall be liable and held to be indebted to the person making application therefor in the sum of \$5 per day per car, applied for and not furnished within the limit of time herein prescribed, except as in this sec tion of this act stated. In addition to the sum of \$5 per car per day so to be due from any railroad failing to furnish said car or cars upon the application hereinbefore mentioned and within the time herein prescribed, any such defaulting railroad shall be held liable and held to be indebted to the person making such applicatherein applied for within the time and as prescribed by this act, in the amount of the acutal damages any such applicant may sustian.




