Encampment of Artillery.	
On August 6 the First battery, Oregon field artillery, will go into camp at Seaside, the camp site being close to the Seaside House and practically the same as where the Third Oregon Infantry was recently encamped. The full battery will be at Seaside under command of Captain H. U. Welsh. A part of the instruction will be in marksmanship and for this purpose 15,000 rounds of ball cartridges will be given by the state for practice with the pistol. The three-inch rifles with which the battery in equipped will have a target range on the beach. The pieces will be placed on the beach and will fire toward Tillamook Head into the side of the mountain, a distance of 3500 or 4500 yards. Over 100 rounds of shrapnel and shell will be used in this practice.—Astorian.	
Getting a Site.	
Considerable interest is being manifested in the location of the Linn Milk Condenser. Various sites are being talked about. It is a business that will bring a good many teams to Albany and at the same time several gasoline launches on the river, hence the appropriateness of a site that will be convenient for both, and one as near the business part of the city as possible for effect alone, as well as convenience wouldn't be out of place. Some one suggests that the site at the foot of Montgomery street, near the iron works, would be a particularly good one, being on the river, and easily reached by those coming into the city from both sides of the river, north, east, south and west.
