RACES AT THE FAIR

No Pools Will Be Sold and Races Must Be Won On Merits

The harness races at the Greater Oregon State fair (September 16-21), which will be the most exciting ever contested on the Pacific coast, have been well exploited, but many persons are inquiring about the running events. No definite decision has been reached. The matter lies with the horsemen themselves.

It is a fact that running races are most profitable to the horsemen themselves when pulled off in conjunction with the betting ring. This year no betting of any kind will be allowed at the fair, and at least the spectators will have the immense satisfaction of knowing that the best horse will win in each race.

W. F. Matlock of Pendleton, a member of the state fair board and chairman of the committee on speed, will make a trip to Seattle, where a big running meet is being held at the Meadows track, to ascertain the disposition of the horsemen there. At all events, the class of running races at Lone Oak track this fall will be high, and all contests will be for blood, and not for the interests of any race track gamblers.
