However, if our petition was not. for the reason stated, sufficient within the meaning of the law of 1907, then the law of 1907, in so far as it attempted to add the additional restriction with respect to title, is void, because it contravenes the direction of the constitution.

Furthermore, if construed directory only, that is to say as advisory to the people, the law might be held to be constitutional; but within the power of the legislature then the law must be liberally construed, and if the petition sufficiently points out the law sought to be referred, so that no one is misled as to what law it is to be voted upon, then it is sufficient compliance with trusted with the mighty power of the statute of 1907, as well as the
