PAINTING THE LILY.

Strange Effects Produced by the Use
of Aniline Dye.

Fashion in flowers has taken a
freak turn in Germany of late, says
the New York Sun, and there is a
great demand in certain circles for
blooms of hues not found in nature.
The flowers are cut with extra long
stalks a few hours before they reach
full maturity. Then the stalks are
put in water in which aniline dyes
have been dissolved. White carnation,
lilies and pansies are the easiest
to dye and give the most natural re-
sults.

As the stalk sucks up the water
the aniline pigment is carried
through all the fine vessels of the
blossom and deposited in its cells,
so that after a few hours its colors
are completely established. Some-
times strange and even beautiful ef-
fects are secured by stopping the
coloring process before it is com-
plete. The white petals will then
be delicately veined with green or
red—these being the colors most
successfully used.

Since the discovery that the flow-
ers are simply dyed there is a great
outcry among floriculturists, who
pronounce the process an outrageous
fraud on nature, both inartistic and
vulgar. This does not prevent the
demand for the dyed flowers from
spreading.

An Immense Poplar.

In the village of Beiersheim, near
Karlsruhe, in Germany, stands the
largest cotton wood tree, or Canadian
poplar, in all Europe.

It is the patriarch of the commu-
nity. It was planted in 1772, and
now, at the age of 135 years, is still
perfectly sound. The tree is 125
feet high, and at the ground has a
circumference of 37 feet, with a di-
ameter of about 12 feet.

This massive trunk is free from
branches to a height of over 30 feet,
and the thick, leafy crown spreads
out in all directions. The cubic con-
tents of the tree amount to 1812
cubic feet.

The American cottonwood was
first introduced in Europe about 1752
and is there known as the Canadian
poplar. It has been extensively
planted throughout Europe, where it
is quite a favorite and is highly re-
commended for planting on account
of its rapid growth. This particu-
lar tree would certainly seem to in-
dicate that in favorable situations it
is able to justify the claims made for it.

The cottonwood has also been
much planted in the United States
and has done much in helping to
reforest the plains. It grows very
rapidly in a fairly moist soil and was
an immense aid to the earlier settlers
of the prairie states. In addition to
its quick growth, it has a large,
spreading crown and is a beautiful
tree, well adapted for park and
other ornamental purposes.

Crosby House to Be Saved.

To a certain number of English-
speaking persons, especially to a
certain or uncertain number, and
not a small number, of American
tourists of a historical or anti-
quarian turn of mind, the news that
Crosby Hall is to be preserved will
be very welcome. Al' London had
given it up for lost. The County
Council had made efforts to preserve
it. But those efforts were reported
to have failed. The oldest house in
London looked fated to fall before
the march of improvement. If
Crosby Hall had been a French
building of the same antiquity and
of equally valuable historical asso-
ciations, it would have been secure.
The government would have ab-
sorbed it and guarded it as a "his-
torical monument." Another proof
that, in Sterne's phrase, "they ord-
these matters better in France."

But the fate of Crosby Hall, un-
der a reign of individualism, has
not thus far been so gloomy. An
enterprising eating house keeper
saw its sentimental possibilities, had
it restored at a large expense, and,
with complete scholarship and skill,
with more of those qualifications
than of taste, the scornor may say,
set out to make of it a luncheon
place for Londoners of the city, and
a Mecca for the American pilgrim,
where he could consume a chop or
a cut from the joint, after the
modern British use. The American
pilgrim availed himself of his
privileges in considerable numbers
and for many years. How could he
not do so? A house which was the
only specimen left in London of the
fifteenth century English Gothic, a
house which antedated the discovery
of America by a full generation, a
house celebrated by Shakespeare in
"Richard III," and authentically re-
stored to its pristine splendor, how
could not the sensitive and culti-
vated American submit himself to
British cookery on such a spot?

To all such lovers of the common
past of Old and New England it was
a shock to learn that Crosby Hall
"must go." It will be a correspond-
ing relief to them to learn that Cros-
by Hall need not go. At the meet-
ing of the London Court of Common
councils a fortnight ago it was an-
nounced that by the efforts of pri-
vate enterprise, assisted by most of
the learned societies, it seemed to
be feasible to effect an exchange of
sites by opening a new street in the
labyrinthine tangle of the neighbor-
hood. This possibility was hailed by
the members of the court, and en-
thusiastically referred to the ap-
propriate committee. It would really
be a reproach to London if the
demolition of this monument were
not prevented.—New York Times.
