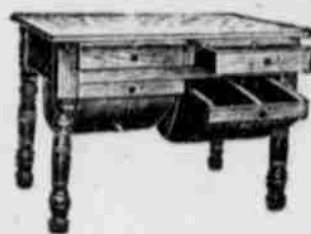

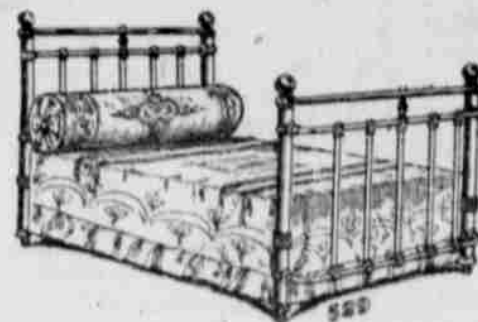

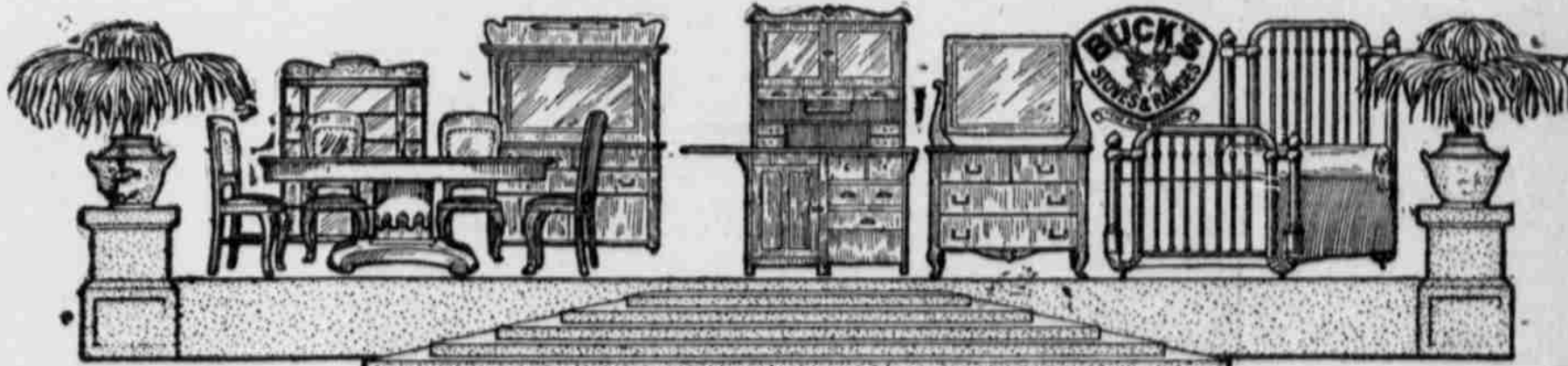

Careful inquiry is to be held, and many women will be deported.
