

PRACTICAL PRESENTS.

Shirt Waist Protector, Collar and Cuffs and Penwiper.

Five inexpensive Christmas gifts that may be made at home are shown in the illustrations. They are particularly suitable for girls. No. 1 is a heart shaped sachet of pale blue china slik, covered with fine linen, on which are embroidered a spray of flowers and French knots. The edge may be finished with a frill of the linen or val adging. A lace bow or ribbon is put at the top. A pretty idea would be to embroider on the linen the flower of the kind of perfume used.

No. 2 is a collar and cuff set of heavy linen intended to be worn with a coat, The shape of the cuffs and collar can be marked on the linen after making an outline with a lead pencil. The scallops may be marked with a half

dollar and the dots with the end of a pencil. The scallops are done in buttonhole stitch and the dots in satin stitch. Launder the linen before cut-

No. 3 is something entirely new, and a woman or girl will find it very useful to protect the front of white shirt waists. It is made of plain white, either linen or muslin. At the waist which a yard and a quarter of ribbon is run. The edges are featherstitched. The tabs on either side at the top may be pinned to the waist or finished with ribbon, which goes over the shoulders and comes down and is fastened to the ribbon at the waist about one inch either side of the center of the back.

No. 5 is a traveling case made from a strip of pretty flowered cretonne and interlined with rubber sheeting. The pockets, which are for the brush, comb, toothbrush, soap and sponge, are made of the sheeting and stitched on. The edges are bound with ribbon. The case rolls and is kept in place by tying it with the ribbon shown at the pointed end.

Gifts Girls Can Make. A spectacle cleaner made from cut leather and filled with chamois leaves is a thoughtful gift, and any little schoolgirl could certainly manage to draw a simple conventional design on the ooze leather, afterward cutting it away with sharp scissors and lining the two rounds with a bit of pretty bright silk. The chamols leaves are cut a wee bit smaller than the leather covers, and all are threaded on a bit of baby ribbon tied with a bow. A very nice penwiper is on the same order as the cleaner, except that the rounds are cut larger and the leaves are made of cloth, the threading together being exactly in the center instead of at one end, as in the case of the spectacle cleaner.

Denim Shoe Bags.

Denim shoe bags are most useful, and to make eight bags a yard and a quarter of material will be needed. Tear the thirty-six inch wide denim into twelve inch strips and cut each of the three strips into three pieces crosswise; double each piece over and sew the seams on the right side, trim them off closely, turn the bag and sew them on the wrong side so as to make a neat fell. When folding the material for the bag allow one side to be three inches longer than the other. This will serve as a flap. The flap should be neatly hemmed by hand and button over the opposite side of the bag with a button and buttonhole.
