The Oregon Electric Railroad is the name of the newly constructed
single-phase electric railway from Portland to Salem, which goes into operation from Salem to West Woodburn December first.
The through train gervice will be put on as soon as the tracks CAN BE BROVGHT UP TO SPECIFICATIONS.
The sixty-foot Pullman passenger cars will be driven each by four 75 horse-power motors, will have electrle heat, air-brakes, and porters. The track will have heavy crumhed rock ballast.
