He Beat Chemawa's Favorite.
Joe Malcolmson, of the Spokane Amateur Athletic Club of Spokane, Washington, had a match 100-yard footrace at Chemawa this morning with Levi Sorter, the crack Indian sprinter. Malcolmson defeated Sorter by two yards in 10 3-5 seconds on a wet clay track. Sorter led for 50 yards, when the speedy white boy overhauled him and won handily. The time was regarded as exceptionally fast, considering the condition of the track.
Malcolmson is one of the best known runners of the country, having run for the past three years under the colors of the Chicago Amateur Athletic Association, and is regarded as the fastest amateur runner in the country, having a record of 30 1-5 seconds for 300 yards. His best time for 10 yards has been 10 seconds, a mark on which he has made on many occasions.
The Spokane boy plays end on the club football team, which lines up against the Indians on the Chemawa field this afternoon.
