

**ONE DEAD, TWO WOUNDED.**

**Bloody Duel Near Jacksonville Saturday Evening.**

A dispatch from Jacksonville Or., dated Dec. 29, says: One man is dead and two seriously wounded as the result of a duel fought with shot-guns and Winchesters at the Mankin ranch, two miles south of this city last evening. The dead man is James Mankin, a prospector and respected rancher. The two wounded men are C. H. Walsworth and the 19-year-old son, N. W. Walsworth.

The trouble arose over an attempt by Mankin to eject Walsworth and family from a house on the Mankin ranch. James Mankin, the dead man, and the senior Walsworth fought with clubs and pitchforks for nearly an hour, when suddenly Walsworth turned and ran into the house and secured a rifle and began shooting at Mankin.

Henry Mankin, brother of the dead man, hearing the report of the rifle, rushed to his brother's assistance with a shotgun and rifle. N. W. Walsworth attempted to shoot Henry Mankin when he himself received a charge of shot in the face and dropped his gun and fled. The elder Walsworth then shot and killed James Mankin. Henry Mankin threw his shotgun aside, secured the rifle, and shot Walsworth in the left eye and through the lower jaw.

Walsworth was brought to this city this evening, the son arriving a few minutes ahead of him. Both are now confined in the county jail.

Henry Mankin has been arrested.

**ATTEMPTED SUICIDE FOLLOWS HUSBAND'S FINE**

Mrs. William Davis Swallows Quantity of Iodine With Suicidal Intent.

Eugene Guard: Mrs. William Davis, who resides in the house on Olive street in the rear of William Young's restaurant attempted to commit suicide Saturday evening about 6 o'clock by swallowing a quantity of iodine, and would have been successful in her attempt had not a physician arrived in the nick of time.

The cause of the attempt at self-destruction is not exactly known by the woman's family, and she refuses to discuss the subject. Her husband is one of the men arrested for selling liquor in violation of the local option law, and he was fined \$100 in the justice court, paying the amount. That may have preyed upon her mind to such an extent as to lead her to attempt to take her life, but her intimate friends say there is probably some other cause.

Mrs. Davis swallowed an ounce of iodine and her throat and the lining of her stomach were terribly burned. The member of the family saw what was done and immediately sent for Dr. Cannon, who soon afterward arrived and applied the proper antidote. He says she is getting along very well today, although she will suffer from the burns for some time yet. The doctor says there was enough of the iodine swallowed to kill several people.

Davis and his wife are hard working people, Davis being employed by Hubble, the drayman, while his wife often takes in washing to help pay the expenses of the family. They have one or two small children.
