
In the Latest Musical Comedy, "Are You Crazy?"



COMING

CHURCHES AND Y.M.C.A.

UNITE TO PROMOTE A HIGHER STANDARD OF RELIGIOUS CULTURE—SERIES OF TEN LECTURES AT SALEM.

Newton N. Riddell, the popular Chautauque lecturer on brain building and soul growth, heredity and prenatal culture, science and religion, has been secured by the Y. M. C. A. to give a series of his lectures in this city beginning Sunday evening, January 5, in the First Methodist church. This will be followed by a series of ten lectures to be given on consecutive evenings.

Mr. Riddell is a professional lecturer and is said to be a master in the art of effective speech. He has been before the public for the past 20 years, filling over 1500 lecture engagements. He is also an author, having written much along the lines of which he lectures. He is a specialist in heredity, psychology, psychic and spiritual phenomena. He speaks from the viewpoint of the scientist. In the course of lectures to be given here, Mr. Riddell proposes to discuss science and its relation to religion; brain building and soul growth; body, soul and spirit and their relation to the physical, psychical and spiritual universe; the physical basis of mind and morals; how to overcome all bad habits and realize the higher virtues; the building of a personality; the scientific evidences of a future life.

The Riddell lectures have been given for years at the summer assemblies at Chautauque, where they have been largely attended.

In order that all may have the privilege of hearing the vital subjects of these lectures discussed, the committee of arrangements has determined that there shall be no admission.

The subject of the opening lecture, Sunday evening, January 5, will be "Science and Religion." This will be a union service of the churches. During the week the lectures will be held in the First Baptist church, question box at 7:45. Lecture at 7 p. m.
